Gen. 19:1-Now the <u>two angels</u> came to Sodom in the evening as Lot was sitting at the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he stood up to meet them and bowed down with his face to the ground.

Heb. 13:2-Do not neglect **hospitality** to strangers, for by this some have entertained angels without knowing it.

Deut. 7:7-The LORD did not make you His beloved nor **choose** you because you were greater in number than any of the peoples, since you were the fewest of all peoples

Jas. 2:23-and the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "AND ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS CREDITED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS," and he was called a **friend of God**.

John 15:14-15-¹⁴ You are My <u>friends</u> if you do what I command you. ¹⁵ No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you <u>friends</u>, because all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.

John 2:23-25-²³ Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many <u>believed</u> in His name as they observed His signs which He was doing. ²⁴ But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, because He knew all people, ²⁵ and because He did not need anyone to testify about mankind, for He Himself knew what was in mankind.

Amos 3:7-Certainly the Lord GOD does nothing Unless He reveals His secret plan To <u>His servants</u> the prophets.

Josh. 4:19-24-¹⁹ Now the people came up from the Jordan on the tenth of the first month and camped at Gilgal, on the eastern edge of Jericho. ²⁰ As for those <u>twelve stones</u> which they had taken from the Jordan, Joshua set *them* up at Gilgal. ²¹ And he said to the sons of Israel, "<u>When your children ask their fathers</u> in time to come, saying, '<u>What are these stones</u>?' ²² then <u>you shall inform your children</u>, saying, 'Israel crossed this Jordan on dry ground.' ²³ For the LORD your God dried up the waters of the <u>Jordan</u> before you until you had crossed, just as the LORD your God had done to the <u>Red Sea</u>, which He dried up before us until we had crossed; ²⁴ so that <u>all the peoples of the earth may know that the hand of the LORD is mighty</u>, so that you may fear the LORD your God forever.

Prov. 22:6-Train up a child in the way he should go, Even when he grows older he will not abandon it.

Eph. 6:4-Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Gen. 15:6-Then he believed in the LORD; and He credited it to him as <u>righteousness</u>.

Micah 6:8-He has told you, mortal one, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you But to do **justice**, to love kindness, And to walk humbly with your God?

Gen. 11:5-Now <u>the LORD came down</u> to see the city and the tower which the men had built

Gen. 11:7-Come, let Us **go down** and there confuse their language, so that they will not understand one another's speech.

Gen. 18:25-Far be it from You to do such a thing, to kill the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous and the wicked are *treated* alike. Far be it from You! **Shall not the Judge of all the earth deal justly**?
