Gen. 13:13-Now the men of Sodom were <u>wicked exceedingly</u> <u>and sinners</u> against the LORD.

Gen. 18:20-And the LORD said, "The <u>outcry</u> of Sodom and Gomorrah is indeed <u>great</u>, and their <u>sin is exceedingly grave</u>."

Gen. 19:7-and said, "Please, my brothers, do not act wickedly.

Gen. 18:23- Abraham came near and said, "Will You indeed sweep away the righteous with the wicked?"

<u>16</u>

1 John 2:15-17-¹⁵ Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God continues *to live* forever.

2 Cor. 6:17-"Therefore, <u>COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE</u> <u>SEPARATE</u>," says the Lord. "AND DO NOT TOUCH WHAT IS UNCLEAN; And I will welcome you."

Matt. 6:22-23-²² "The eye is the lamp of the body; so then if your eye is clear, your whole body will be full of light. ²³ But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light that is in you is darkness, how great is the darkness!
