Gen. 3:22-Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of <u>Us</u>, knowing good and evil; and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take also from the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"—

Gen. 11:7-Come, let <u>Us</u> go down and there confuse their language, so that they will not understand one another's speech.

Isa. 6:8-Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for <u>Us</u>?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

Ps. 11:3-If the foundations are destroyed, What can the righteous do?

Gen. 14:2-*that* they made war with Bera king of <u>Sodom</u>, and with Birsha king of <u>Gomorrah</u>, Shinab king of <u>Admah</u>, and Shemeber king of <u>Zeboiim</u>, and the king of <u>Bela (that is, Zoar)</u>.

Gen. 14:8-And the king of <u>Sodom</u> and the king of <u>Gomorrah</u> and the king of <u>Admah</u> and the king of <u>Zeboiim</u> and the king of <u>Bela</u> (<u>that is, Zoar</u>) came out; and they arrayed for battle against them in the valley of Siddim.

Deut. 29:23- 'All its land is brimstone and salt, a burning waste, unsown and unproductive, and no grass grows in it, like the overthrow of **Sodom and Gomorrah**, **Admah and Zeboiim**, which the LORD overthrew in His anger and in His wrath.'

Josh. 1:8- This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall **meditate on it day and night**, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.

Ps. 1:2-But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he **meditates day and night**.

Col. 3:2-Set your **mind** on the things above, not on the things that are on earth.

Philip. 4:8-Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, **dwell** on these things.

Luke 17:32-33- ³² Remember Lot's wife. ³³ Whoever seeks to keep his life will lose it, and whoever loses *his life* will preserve it.

1 John 2:15-17-¹⁵ Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. ¹⁷ The world is passing away and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God continues *to live* forever.

2 Tim. 4:10-for <u>Demas, having loved this present world, has</u> <u>deserted me</u> and gone to Thessalonica; Crescens *has* gone to Galatia, Titus to Dalmatia.

2 Tim. 4:8-in the future there is laid up for me the <u>crown of</u> <u>righteousness</u>, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also <u>to all who have loved His appearing</u>.

Gen. 19:14-Lot went out and spoke to his sons-in-law, who were to marry his daughters, and said, "Up, get out of this place, for the Lord will destroy the city." But he appeared to his sons-in-law to be **jesting**.

Gen. 18:22-Then the men turned away from there and went toward Sodom, while Abraham was still standing before the LORD.

<u>28</u>

Isa. 13:19-And Babylon, the beauty of kingdoms, the glory of the Chaldeans' pride, Will be as when God overthrew **Sodom and Gomorrah**.

Jer. 50:40-As when God overthrew **Sodom And Gomorrah** with its neighbors," declares the Lord, "No man will live there, Nor will any son of man reside in it."

Rev. 19:2-3-² BECAUSE HIS JUDGMENTS ARE TRUE AND RIGHTEOUS; for He has judged the great <u>harlot</u> who was corrupting the earth with her immorality, and HE HAS AVENGED THE BLOOD OF HIS BOND-SERVANTS ON HER." And a second time they said, "Hallelujah! <u>HER SMOKE RISES UP FOREVER AND EVER.</u>"

Jonah 3:4-Then Jonah began to go through the city one day's walk; and he cried out and said, "Yet forty days and Nineveh will be overthrown."

Jonah 4:5-Then Jonah went out from the city and sat east of it. There he made a shelter for himself and sat under it in the shade until he could **see what would happen in the city**.

<u>29</u>

Gen. 8:1-But <u>God remembered Noah</u> and all the beasts and all the cattle that were with him in the ark; and God caused a wind to pass over the earth, and the water subsided.

Gen. 19:13-for we are about to destroy this place, because their outcry has become so great before the LORD that **the LORD has sent us to destroy it**.

Jas. 5:16-Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.
