

1. Taking into consideration the following:

- The antichrist appears on the scene at the beginning of the 7-year tribulation.
- The abomination of desolation occurs in the middle of the 7-year tribulation;
- Israel will be burying the dead and burning weapons for 7 years.

Where does "Ezekiel's War" fit into this timeline?

2. Did Matthew, and him only, include the resurrection of the bodies of the saints as a preview and assurance to the new Jewish believers in the Messiah? Could he have included this event in his Gospel as an assurance to the believers of the ultimate fulfillment of Ezek. 37:11-14? I ask because Matthew wrote his Gospel to the new Jewish believers to prove that this Jesus was in fact the Messiah, Matt. 1:1,18. It seems strange the Matthew would include this singular event that none of the other Gospel writers even mention unless it was for the purpose of giving encouragement and hope that God will yet in fact do what He said in Ezek. 37:11-14. Maybe as a preview or fore view?

3. Could you compile a list of the most major prophetic stage setting events that are presently taking place?

4. My question has not so much to do with the timing of the Ezekiel 38 war as it does with the aftermath of the war: the timing of the burial of the bodies (for 7 months) and the

birds feasting on their flesh. My understanding of what you have said is that you tend to place the Ezekiel 38 war near the beginning of the 7-year Tribulation period somewhere around the 1st and 2nd Seal Judgements, and the described aftermath of Ezekiel 39 at the end of the 7-year Tribulation period (which is when I think you say the birds will feast on the flesh of the dead bodies). [My reading of Ezek. 38] has me thinking the war / intended attack on Israel is stopped in its tracks on the mountains of Israel [by God] before it really gets started, and that God quickly destroys the would-be invaders (in a day so to speak). If this is the case, and the war does not drag on into the latter part of the 2nd half of the 7-year Tribulation period, my mind doesn't track with the idea of the flesh-eating feast taking place near the end of the 7 years. I am thinking the burial of the dead bodies (over a 7-month period) would start relatively soon after God destroys the invaders, and the birds feasting on their flesh would take place at the same time (while there are bodies still unburied available to eat). Can you please help me make sense of this? Where am I confused; what am I missing?

5. In Ezekiel 39:4-6, it says that Gog will die in the conflict. It also says in Ezekiel 39:11 that he will be buried there along with his horde. Like you, I believe Gog is the current or future leader of Russia, but I find it confusing that he would die on the battlefield since leaders of countries no longer participate in the actual fighting as they did in ancient times. It would be the equivalent of Putin being on the front

lines with his troops in Ukraine. Can you clear this up for me?

6. Are you able to elaborate more on your view as to why you think that the Ezekiel war coincides with the 2nd seal judgment?
7. Also, what do you think of the view of the rapture and Ezekiel war occurring simultaneously as that also seems to be a common viewpoint of when the Ezekiel war will occur.
