I know there will be two resurrections for believers at the Rapture and after the Tribulation. Did Bible mention the resurrection of believers who died during the Millennium?

6. Will Israel believe that the Anti-Christ is the Messiah for the 1st half of the Tribulation? I ask because if they will, why would the Abomination of Desolation be bad in their eyes? If they believe he is "Jesus" then they wouldn't oppose worshiping him in the temple?
