Num. 23:19-<u>God is not a man, that He should lie</u>, Nor a son of man, that He should repent; Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?

Titus 1:2-in the hope of eternal life, which <u>God, who cannot</u> <u>lie</u>, promised long ages ago

Heb. 6:18-so that by two unchangeable things in which <u>it is</u> <u>impossible for God to lie</u>, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.

## <u>18</u>

John 13:17-If you <u>know</u> these things, you are <u>blessed</u> if you <u>do</u> them.

Jas. 1:22-But prove yourselves <u>doers</u> of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves.

## <u>20</u>

Gen. 11:27-Now these are *the records of* the generations of Terah. <u>Terah became the father of Abram, Nahor and Haran</u>; and Haran became the father of Lot

Job 1:1-There was a man in <u>the land of Uz</u> whose name was Job; and that man was blameless, upright, fearing God and turning away from evil. Josh. 24:2-Joshua said to all the people, "Thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, 'From ancient times <u>your fathers lived beyond</u> <u>the River, *namely*, Terah, the father of Abraham and the father of Nahor, and they served other gods</u>.
