Act 7:22-Moses was educated in all the learning of the **Egyptians**, and he was a man of power in words and deeds.

<u>16</u>

Gen. 17:20-As for <u>Ishmael</u>, I have heard you; behold, I will bless him, and will make him fruitful and will multiply him exceedingly. <u>He shall become the father of twelve princes</u>, and I will make him a great nation.

<u>17</u>

Gen. 25:8-Abraham breathed his last and <u>died</u> in a ripe old age, an old man and satisfied with life; and he was gathered to his people.

Gen. 3:19- By the sweat of your face You will eat bread, Till you return to the ground, Because from it you were taken; For you are dust, And to dust you shall return.

Heb. 9:27-And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to <u>die once</u> and after this *comes* judgment

Matt. 27:50-And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His **spirit**.

Acts 7:59-They went on stoning Stephen as he called on *the Lord* and said, "Lord Jesus, receive my **spirit**!"

Heb. 2:15-and might <u>free those who through fear of death</u> were subject to slavery all their lives.

2 Cor. 5:8-we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be **absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord**.

Philip. 1:21-23-²¹ For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²² But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. ²³ But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is very much better.

Gen. 25:8-Abraham breathed his last and <u>died</u> in a ripe old age, an old man and satisfied with life; and <u>he was gathered to his people</u>.

<u>18</u>

Gen. 25:6-but to the sons of his concubines, Abraham gave gifts while he was still living, and **sent them away from his son Isaac eastward, to the land of the east**.

Gen. 16:11-12-¹¹ The angel of the LORD said to her further, "Behold, you are with child, and you will bear a son; And you shall call his name <u>Ishmael</u>, Because the LORD has given heed to your affliction. ¹² "He will be a wild donkey of a man, <u>Hishand will be against everyone</u>, and everyone's hand will be against him; And he will live to the east of all his brothers."
