Acts 23:26-Claudius Lysias, to the **most excellent** governor Felix, greetings.

Acts 24:3-we acknowledge *this* in every way and everywhere, **most excellent** Felix, with all thankfulness.

Acts 26:25-But Paul said, "I am not out of my mind, <u>most</u> <u>excellent</u> Festus, but I utter words of sober truth.

Luke 24:50-51-50 And He led them out as far as Bethany, and He lifted up His hands and blessed them. 51 While He was blessing them, He parted from them and was **carried up into heaven**.

Luke 24:49-And behold, I am sending forth <u>the promise of My</u> <u>Father</u> upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high.

Acts 11:15-16-15 And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them just as *He did* upon us at the beginning. 16 And I remembered the word of the Lord, how He used to say, 'John baptized with water, but you will be **baptized with the Holy Spirit**.'

Ezek. 39:28-29-28 Then they will know that I am the Lord their God because I made them go into exile among the nations, and then gathered them *again-to* their own land; and I will leave none of them there any longer. 29 I will not hide My face from them any longer, for I will have **poured out My Spirit** on the house of Israel," declares the Lord God.

Luke 11:13-So if you, despite being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give **the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him**?

Matt. 12:46-50-46 While He was still speaking to the crowds, behold, His mother and brothers were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him. 47 Someone said to Him, "Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside seeking to speak to You." 48 But Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, "Who is My mother and who are My brothers?" 49 And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, "Behold My mother and My brothers! 50 For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother."

Matt. 13:55-56-55 Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary, and His **brothers**, **James and Joseph and Simon and Judas**? 56 And His **sisters**, are they not all with us? Where then *did* this man *get* all these things?"

Mark 3:31-Then His mother and His **brothers** arrived, and standing outside they sent *word* to Him and called Him.

John 7:3-5-3 Therefore His **brothers** said to Him, "Leave here and go into Judea, so that Your disciples also may see Your works which You are doing. 4 For no one does anything in secret when he himself seeks to be *known* publicly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world." 5 For not even His **brothers** were believing in Him.

1 Cor. 15:7-then He appeared to **James**, then to all the apostles.

Matt. 27:3-5-3 Then when Judas, who had betrayed Him, saw that He had been condemned, he felt remorse and returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, 4 saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." But they said, "What is that to us? See *to that* yourself!" 5 And he threw the pieces of silver into the temple sanctuary and departed; and he went away and **hanged himself**.

Col. 4:14-<u>Luke, the beloved physician</u>, sends you his greetings, and *also* Demas.

Ps. 69:25-May their camp be desolate; May none dwell in their tents.

Ps. 109:8-Let his days be few; Let another take his office.

- Mark 1:4-<u>John the Baptist</u> appeared in the wilderness preaching a <u>baptism of repentance</u> for the forgiveness of sins.
- Eph. 2:20-having been built on the <u>foundation of the apostles</u> and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone.
- 1 Cor. 15:9-For <u>I am the least of the apostles</u>, and not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.
- Eph. 3:8-To me, the very <u>least of all saints</u>, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ.
- Acts 14:4-But the people of the city were divided; and some sided with the Jews, while others, with the **apostles**.
- Acts 14:14- But when the **apostles** Barnabas and Paul heard about it, they tore their robes and rushed out into the crowd, crying out.
- 2 Cor. 8:23-As for Titus, he is my partner and fellow worker among you; as for our brothers, they are **messengers** of the churches, a glory to Christ.
- Rom. 16:7-Greet Andronicus and Junia, my kinsfolk and my fellow prisoners, who are outstanding in the view of the **apostles**, who also were in Christ before me.
- Phil. 2:25-But I thought it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother and fellow worker and fellow soldier, who is also your **messenger** and minister to my need.

2 Cor. 5:8-we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

Philip. 1:21-23-21 For to me, to live is Christ and <u>to die is</u> gain. 22 But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. 23 But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for *that* is <u>very much better</u>.

John 6:64-But there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were **who did not believe**, and who it was that would betray Him.

John 6:71-Now He meant Judas *the son* of Simon Iscariot, for he, one of the twelve, was going **to betray Him**.

Matt. 26:24-The Son of Man is going away just as it is written about Him; but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been good for that man if he had not been born.

John 17:12-While I was with them, I was keeping them in Your name which You have given Me; and I guarded them and not one of them perished but the **son of perdition**, so that the Scripture would be fulfilled.

2 Thess. 2:3-Let no one in any way deceive you, for *it will not come* unless the apostasy comes first, and the **man of lawlessness** is revealed, the son of destruction.

Lev. 16:8-Aaron shall **cast lots** for the two goats, one lot for the Lord and the other lot for the scapegoat.

Neh. 10:34-Likewise we <u>cast lots</u> for the supply of wood *among* the priests, the Levites and the people so that they might bring it to the house of our God, according to our fathers' households, at fixed times annually, to burn on the altar of the Lord our God, as it is written in the law

Neh. 11:1-Now the leaders of the people lived in Jerusalem, but the rest of the people <u>cast lots</u> to bring one out of ten to live in Jerusalem, the holy city, while nine-tenths *remained* in the *other* cities.

Josh. 14:2-by the <u>lot of their inheritance</u>, as the Lord commanded through Moses, for the nine tribes and the half-tribe.

Prov. 16:33-The <u>lot is cast</u> into the lap, but its every decision is from the Lord.

Jonah 1:7-And each man said to his mate, "Come, let's <u>cast lots</u> so that we may find out on whose account this catastrophe has struck us." So they cast lots, and the lot fell on Jonah.

Eph. 2:20-having been built on the **foundation of the apostles** and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner *stone*.

Matt. 19:28-And Jesus said to them, "Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of Man

will sit on His glorious throne, you also shall sit upon <u>twelve</u> <u>thrones</u>, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

Rev. 21:14-And the wall of the city had twelve foundation stones, and on them *were* the twelve names of the **twelve apostles** of the Lamb.

Acts 2:14-But Peter, taking his stand with the other <u>eleven</u>, raised his voice and declared to them: "Men of Judea and all you who live in Jerusalem, know this, and pay attention to my words.

Acts 6:2-So <u>the twelve</u> summoned the congregation of the disciples and said, "It is not desirable for us to neglect the word of God in order to serve tables.
