Pastor Brian McLaren meditates on the virgin birth in the "<u>Be</u> Still and Go" podcast of The Riverside Church in New York City. In a segment titled "<u>A Post-Patriarchal Christmas</u>," McLaren took issue with the virgin birth as a "<u>science-defying miracle that</u> proved something about Jesus." He protested, "<u>This approach</u> never really worked for me. How can you use something you can't prove—a virgin birth long ago—to prove something else—the unique identity of Jesus?" McLaren draws a different conclusion. He says <u>the virgin birth's "greatest value isn't in</u> proving something, but in meaning something." McLaren said God got so <u>tired of men "messing things up</u>" that he said, "<u>I'm</u> going to work directly with women for a change. I'm taking a <u>step to overthrow the patriarchy</u>." Whether you believe the "<u>virgin birth story</u>" or not, McLaren said, its "<u>literal factuality</u>" is "<u>not the point</u>." McLaren concluded the virgin birth is "about a profound rejection of violence," the notion that peace can never come through the old, blood-stained path of patriarchy.

MATTHEW 26:59 – Now the chief priests and <u>the whole Council</u> <u>kept trying to obtain false testimony against Jesus</u>, so that they might put Him to death.

JOHN 13:23 – There was reclining on Jesus' bosom one of His disciples, whom Jesus loved.

1 JOHN 2:1 – My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, <u>Jesus Christ the righteous</u>
