## <u>3:11</u>

John 16:12-13-<sup>12</sup> "I have many <u>more things</u> to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. <sup>13</sup> But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is <u>to come</u>.

John 14:26-But the Helper, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in My name, He will **teach you** all things, and **remind** you of all that I said to you.

1 Cor. 7:10-But to the married I give instructions, **not I, but the Lord**, that the wife should not leave her husband.

1 Cor. 7:12-But to the rest <u>I say</u>, not the <u>Lord</u>, that if any brother has a wife who is an unbeliever, and she consents to live with him, he must not divorce her.

2 Pet. 3:15-16-<sup>15</sup> and regard the patience of our Lord *as* salvation; just as also our beloved brother <u>Paul</u>, according to the <u>wisdom</u> <u>given him, wrote to you</u>, <sup>16</sup> as also in all *his* letters, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which the untaught and unstable distort, as *they do* also the rest of the Scriptures, to their own destruction.

1 Thess. 4:¹-Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that <u>as you received from us instruction</u> as to how you ought to walk and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more.

1 Thess. 4:8-So, <u>he who rejects this is not rejecting man but</u> the God who gives His Holy Spirit to you.

- 1 Cor. 6:1-Does any one of you, when he has a case against his neighbor, dare to go to law **before the unrighteous** and not before the saints?
- 1 Cor. 6:6-but brother goes to law with brother, and that before <u>unbelievers</u>?
- 1 Tim. 3:7-And he must have <u>a good reputation with those</u> <u>outside the church</u>, so that he will not fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.
- Eph. 4:28-He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good, **so that he will have something to share with one who has need**.

## <u>4:13-18</u>

Philip. 1:21-23-<sup>21</sup> For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. <sup>22</sup> But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. <sup>23</sup> But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to <u>depart and be with Christ</u>, for *that* is very much better.

2 Cor. 5:8-we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

- Luke 23:43-And He said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in **Paradise**."
- 2 Cor. 12:4-was caught up into **Paradise** and heard inexpressible words, which a man is not permitted to speak.
- 1 Thess. 5:9-For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.
