1 Cor. 1 26-29-<sup>26</sup> For consider your calling, brethren, that there were not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble; <sup>27</sup> but God has chosen the foolish things of the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to shame the things which are strong, <sup>28</sup> and the base things of the world and the despised God has chosen, the things that are not, so that He may nullify the things that are, <sup>29</sup> so that no man may boast before God.

## <u>17</u>

Isa. 6:3-And one called out to another and said, "Holy, Holy, Holy, is the Lord of armies. The whole earth is full of His glory."

Isa. 6:5-Then I said, "Woe to me, for <u>I am ruined</u>! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I live among a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of armies."

Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you." <sup>49</sup> Nathanael answered Him,

"Rabbi, You are the Son of God; You are the King of Israel." <sup>50</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, "Because I said to you that I saw you under the fig tree, do you believe? You will see greater things than these." And He said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see the heavens opened and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."

1 Tim. 2:5-For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus.

Job 9:32-33-For *He is* not a man as I am that I may answer Him, that we may go to court together. There is no umpire between us, who may lay his hand upon us both.

## <u>18</u>

Josh. 4:19-24-19 Now the people came up from the Jordan on the tenth of the first month and camped at Gilgal on the eastern edge of Jericho. 20 <u>Those twelve stones which they had taken from the Jordan, Joshua set up at Gilgal</u>. 21 He said to the sons of Israel, "When your children ask their fathers in time to come, saying, 'What are these stones?' 22 then you shall inform your children, saying, 'Israel crossed this Jordan on dry ground.' 23 For the Lord your God dried up the waters of the Jordan before you until you had crossed, just as the Lord your God had done to the Red Sea, which He dried up before us until we had crossed;24 that all the peoples of the earth may know that the hand of the Lord is mighty, so that you may fear the Lord your God forever."

- Gen. 12:8-Then he proceeded from there to the mountain on the east of **Bethel**, and pitched his tent, with **Bethel** on the west and Ai on the east; and there he built an altar to the Lord and called upon the name of the Lord.
- Hos. 12:4-Yes, he wrestled with the angel and prevailed; He wept and sought His favor. He found Him at **Bethel** And there He spoke with us.
- Gen. 35:6-So Jacob came to <u>Luz (that is, Bethel)</u>, which is in the land of Canaan, he and all the people who were with him.
- Gen. 48:3-Then Jacob said to Joseph, "God Almighty appeared to me at <u>Luz</u> in the land of Canaan and blessed me.
- Josh. 16:2-It went from **Bethel to Luz**, and continued to the border of the Archites at Ataroth.
- 2 Cor. 5:17-Therefore if anyone is in Christ, *he is* a <u>new creature</u>; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.
- Rev. 3:12-He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the <u>name</u> of My God, and the <u>name</u> of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new <u>name</u>.
- Rev. 21:5-And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true."

Jonah 2:9-But I will sacrifice to You With the voice of thanksgiving. That which I have **vowed** I will pay. Salvation is from the Lord.

Matt. 28:20-teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

Heb. 13:5-Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you."

Isa. 54:17-No weapon that is formed against you will prosper; And every tongue that accuses you in judgment you will condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, And their vindication is from Me," declares the LORD.

Philip. 4:19-And my God will supply all your <u>needs</u> according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
