1. Only for the Church Age Believer

Exod. 23:16-Also *you shall observe* the Feast of the Harvest *of* the <u>**first fruits**</u> of your labors *from* what you sow in the field; also the Feast of the Ingathering at the end of the year when you gather in *the fruit of* your labors from the field.

Lev. 23:10-12-¹⁰ "Speak to the sons of Israel and say to them, 'When you enter the land which I am going to give to you and <u>reap its harvest</u>, then you shall bring in the sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest. ¹¹ He shall wave the sheaf before the LORD for you to be accepted; on the day after the sabbath the priest shall wave it. ¹² Now on the day when you wave the sheaf, you shall offer a male lamb one year old without defect for a burnt offering to the LORD.

Lev. 19:9-10-⁹ 'Now when you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not reap to the very corners of your field, nor shall you gather the **gleanings** of your harvest. ¹⁰ Nor shall you glean your vineyard, nor shall you gather the fallen fruit of your vineyard; you shall leave them for **the needy and for the stranger**. I am the LORD your God.

2 Cor. 5:8-we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be **absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord**.

Philip. 1:21-23-²¹ For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. ²² But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. ²³ But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire to <u>depart and be</u> with Christ, for *that* is very much better.

Luke 16:22-Now the poor man died and was carried away by the angels to <u>Abraham's bosom</u>; and the rich man also died and was buried.

Luke 16:20- And a poor man named <u>Lazarus</u> was laid at his gate, covered with sores.

Luke 16:22-Now the poor man died and was carried away by the angels to <u>Abraham's</u> bosom; and the rich man also died and was buried.

Luke 16:29-But Abraham said, 'They have <u>Moses</u> and the <u>**Prophets**</u>; let them hear them.'

Luke 23:43-And He said to him, "Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in <u>Paradise</u>."

2 Cor. 12:4-was caught up into <u>**Paradise**</u> and heard inexpressible words, which a man is not permitted to speak.

Luke 16:23-In <u>Hades</u> he lifted up his eyes, being in torment, and saw Abraham far away and Lazarus in his bosom.

Rev. 20:13-14-¹³ And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and <u>Hades</u> gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one *of them* according to their deeds. ¹⁴ Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.

2. <u>Pre-Trib. Rapture</u>

a. <u>Imminency</u>

Jas. 5:8- You too be patient; strengthen your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is <u>near</u>.

1 Cor. 1:7- so that you are not lacking in any gift, <u>awaiting</u> <u>eagerly the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ</u>.

Philip. 3:20- For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also <u>we</u> <u>eagerly wait for a Savior</u>, the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 John 3:2-3-² Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. ³ And <u>everyone who has this hope *fixed* on Him purifies</u> <u>himself, just as He is pure</u>.

Jas. 2:10-For whoever keeps the whole law and yet <u>stumbles in</u> <u>one point, he has become guilty of all</u>.

Rom. 6:14-For sin shall not be master over you, for <u>you are not</u> <u>under law</u> but under grace.

b. <u>Exemption from Divine Wrath</u>

1 Thess. 5:9-For God has not destined us for <u>wrath</u>, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Rom. 5:9- Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the <u>wrath</u> of God through Him.

Rom. 8:1-Therefore there is now **<u>no condemnation</u>** for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Rev. 3:10-Because you have kept the word of My perseverance, \underline{I} also will keep you from the hour of testing, that *hour* which is about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.

Rev. 11:18- And the nations were enraged, and Your <u>wrath</u> came, and the time *came* for the dead to be judged, and *the time* to reward Your bond-servants the prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth."

Rev. 14:10-he also will drink of the wine of the **wrath** of God, which is mixed in full strength in the cup of His anger; and he will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.

Rev. 15:1-Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels who had seven plagues, *which are* the last, because in them the <u>wrath</u> of God is finished.

Rev. 15:7-Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the **wrath** of God, who lives forever and ever.

Rev. 16:1-Then I heard a loud voice from the temple, saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the <u>wrath</u> of God."

Rev. 16:19-The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. Babylon the great was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of His fierce <u>wrath</u>.

Rev. 19:15-From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce <u>wrath</u> of God, the Almighty.
