1 Cor. 7:25-<u>Now concerning</u> virgins I have no command of the Lord, but I give an opinion as one who by the mercy of the Lord is trustworthy.

1 Cor. 8:1-<u>Now concerning</u> things sacrificed to idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge makes arrogant, but love edifies.

1 Cor. 12:1-<u>Now concerning</u> spiritual *gifts*, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware.

1 Cor. 16:1-<u>Now concerning</u> the collection for the saints, as I directed the churches of Galatia, so do you also.

John 5:43-I have come in My Father's name, and you do not receive Me; if another comes in his own name, you will receive him.

Rev. 6:1-4-¹ Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come." ²I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer. ³ When He broke the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come." ⁴ And another, a red horse, went out; and to him who sat on it, it was granted <u>to take peace from the earth</u>, and that *men* would slay one another; and a great sword was given to him.

Rom. 1:18-32-¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, ¹⁹ because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them.²⁰ For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse. ²¹ For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. ²² Professing be to wise. they became fools, ²³ and <u>exchanged</u> the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures. ²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them. ²⁵ For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. ²⁶ For this reason God gave them over to degrading passions; for their women exchanged the natural function for that which is unnatural, ²⁷ and in the same way also the **men abandoned** the natural function of the woman and burned in their desire toward one another, men with men committing indecent acts and receiving in their own persons the due penalty of their error. ²⁸ And just as <u>they did not see fit</u> to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper, ²⁹ being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; they are gossips, ³⁰ slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, ³¹ without understanding, untrustworthy, unloving,

unmerciful; ³² and although they know the ordinance of God, that those who practice such things are worthy of death, <u>they not only</u> <u>do</u> the same, but also <u>give hearty approval</u> to those who practice them.

Matt. 24:8-But all these things are *merely* the beginning of **<u>birth</u> <u>pangs</u>**.

Heb. 11:6-And <u>without faith it is impossible to please *Him*</u>, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and *that* He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

Eph. 6:14b-Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH, and HAVING PUT ON THE **BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS.**

Rev. 19:15-From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce <u>wrath</u> of God, the Almighty.

1 Tim. 2:5-For there is one God, *and* <u>one mediator</u> also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus.

1 Cor. 15:58-Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that **your toil is not** *in* **vain in** the Lord.

Eph. 4:29-Let **no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth**, but only such *a word* as is good for **edification** according to the need *of the moment*, so that it will give grace to those who hear.
