1 Thess. 5:9-For God has not destined us for <u>wrath</u>, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Rom. 5:9-Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the **wrath** of God through Him.

Rom. 8:1-Therefore there is now **no condemnation** for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Rev. 3:10-Because you have kept the word of My perseverance, <u>I</u> also will keep you from the hour of testing, that hour which is about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.

Rev. 11:18- And the nations were enraged, and Your <u>wrath</u> came, and the time *came* for the dead to be judged, and *the time* to reward Your bondservants the prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth."

Rev. 14:10-he also will drink of the wine of the <u>wrath</u> of God, which is mixed in full strength in the cup of His anger; and he will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.

Rev. 15:1-Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels who had seven plagues, which are the last, because in them the **wrath** of God is finished.

Rev. 15:7-Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the **wrath** of God, who lives forever and ever.

Rev. 16:1-Then I heard a loud voice from the temple, saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the **wrath** of God."

Rev. 16:19-The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. Babylon the great was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of His fierce **wrath**.

Rev. 19:15-From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce **wrath** of God, the Almighty.

1 Tim. 2:5-For there is one God, *and* <u>one mediator</u> also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus.

Matt. 7:13-14-¹³ Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. ¹⁴ For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Gal. 2:21-I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness *comes* through the Law, then Christ died **needlessly**.

Rom. 5:8-But <u>God demonstrates His own love toward us</u>, in that while we were yet sinners, <u>Christ died for us</u>.

1 Cor. 15:58-<u>Therefore</u>, my beloved brethren, <u>be steadfast</u>, <u>immovable</u>, <u>always abounding in the work of the Lord</u>, knowing that <u>your toil is not in vain in</u> the Lord.

Eph. 4:29-Let <u>no unwholesome word proceed from your</u> <u>mouth</u>, but only such *a word* as is good for <u>edification</u> according to the need *of the moment*, so that it will give grace to those who hear.
