1 Cor. 15:58-<u>Therefore</u>, my beloved brethren, <u>be steadfast</u>, <u>immovable</u>, <u>always abounding in the work of the Lord</u>, knowing that <u>your toil is not *in* vain in</u> the Lord.

Jas. 5:7-10-⁷ Therefore be <u>patient</u>, brethren, until the <u>coming of</u> <u>the Lord</u>. The farmer waits for the precious produce of the soil, being <u>patient</u> about it, until it gets the early and late rains. ⁸ You too be <u>patient; strengthen your hearts</u>, for <u>the coming of the</u> <u>Lord is near</u>. ⁹ Do not <u>complain</u>, brethren, against one another, so that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, <u>the Judge is</u> <u>standing right at the door</u>. ¹⁰ As <u>an example, brethren, of</u> <u>suffering and patience</u>, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.

1 John 3:2-3-² Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that <u>when</u> <u>He appears</u>, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. ³ And everyone who has this <u>hope fixed</u> on Him <u>purifies</u> <u>himself</u>, just as He is pure.

1 Cor. 3:6-I planted, Apollos watered, but <u>God was causing the</u> <u>growth</u>.

Eph. 4:29-Let **no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth**, but only such *a word* as is good for **edification** according to the need *of the moment*, so that it will give grace to those who hear.

Prov. 18:21-**Death and life are in the power of the tongue**, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

1 Cor. 12:7-But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the <u>common good</u>.

1 Cor. 14:3-But the one who prophesies speaks to people for <u>edification, exhortation, and consolation</u>.

1 Cor. 14:12-So also you, since you are zealous of spiritual *gifts*, seek to abound <u>for the edification of the church</u>.

1 Cor. 14:26-What is the outcome then, brethren? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done <u>for</u> <u>edification</u>.

1 Pet. 4:10-As each one has received a special gift, employ it in **serving one another** as good stewards of the multifaceted grace of God.

Gal. 6:9-Let's not become discouraged in doing good, for in due time we will reap, <u>if we do not become weary</u>.

Gal. 6:9 (NIV) -Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest **<u>if we do not give up</u>**.
