Introduction

<u>15</u>

Gen. 50:20-As for you, you meant evil against me, **but God** meant it for good in order to bring about this present result, to preserve many people alive.

<u>16</u>

Gen. 29:18-Now <u>Jacob loved Rachel</u>, so he said, "I will serve you seven years for your younger daughter Rachel."

Gen. 29:20-So Jacob served seven years for Rachel and they seemed to him but a few days because of **his love for her**.

Gen. 37:35-Then all his sons and all his <u>daughters</u> arose to comfort him, but he refused to be comforted. And he said, "Surely I will go down to Sheol in mourning for my son." So his father wept for him.

Gen. 46:7-his sons and his grandsons with him, his <u>daughters</u> and his granddaughters, and all his descendants he brought with him to Egypt.

Gen. 46:15-These are the sons of Leah, whom she bore to Jacob in Paddan-aram, with his **daughter Dinah**; all his sons and his **daughters** *numbered* thirty-three.

Gen. 9:20-24-²⁰ Then Noah began farming and planted a vineyard. ²¹ He drank of the wine and became drunk, and uncovered himself inside his tent. ²² Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brothers outside. ²³ But Shem and Japheth took a garment and laid it upon both their shoulders and walked backward and covered the nakedness of their father; and their faces were turned away, so that they did not see their father's nakedness. ²⁴ When Noah awoke from his wine, he knew what his youngest son had done to him. ²⁵ So he said, "Cursed be Canaan; A servant of servants He shall be to his brothers."

Philip. 1:6-For I am confident of this very thing, that <u>He who</u> began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

Eph. 2:10-For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which <u>God prepared beforehand</u> so that we would walk in them.
