John 10:10-<u>The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy;</u> I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.

### <u>28</u>

Luke 10:7-Stay in that house, eating and drinking what they give you; for <u>the laborer is worthy of his wages</u>. Do not keep moving from house to house.

Gen. 31:7-Yet **your father has cheated me and changed my wages ten times**; however, God did not allow him to hurt me.

## <u>29</u>

Luke 16:10-<u>He who is faithful in a very little thing is faithful</u> <u>also in much</u>; and he who is unrighteous in a very little thing is unrighteous also in much.

#### <u>33</u>

Dan. 6:4-5-<sup>4</sup>Then the commissioners and satraps began trying to find a ground of accusation against Daniel in regard to government affairs; but they could find no ground of accusation or evidence of corruption, inasmuch as he was faithful, and <u>no negligence or corruption</u> was to be found in him. <sup>5</sup>Then these men said, "We will not find any ground of accusation against this Daniel unless we find *it* against him with regard to the law of his God."

## <u>35</u>

Gal. 6:6-9-<sup>6</sup> The one who is taught the word is to share all good things with the one who teaches *him*. <sup>7</sup> Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap. <sup>8</sup> For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. <sup>9</sup> Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary.

# <u>36</u>

Luke 16:10-<u>He who is faithful in a very little thing is faithful</u> <u>also in much</u>; and he who is unrighteous in a very little thing is unrighteous also in much.

1 Pet. 2:21-23-<sup>21</sup> For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an <u>example</u> for you to follow in His steps, <sup>22</sup> WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH; <sup>23</sup> and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting *Himself* to Him who judges righteously.

# <u>43</u>

1 Tim. 6:10-For the <u>love of money is a root</u> of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs. 1 Tim. 6:17-19-<sup>17</sup> Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, <u>who richly supplies us with all things to</u> <u>enjoy</u>. <sup>18</sup> *Instruct them* to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, <sup>19</sup> storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life indeed.

Matt. 27:57-When it was evening, there came a <u>**rich man**</u> from Arimathea, named Joseph, who himself had also become a <u>**disciple**</u> of Jesus.

Ps. 37:4-Delight yourself in the LORD; And He will give you the desires of your heart.
