The great American statesman Daniel Webster was once asked, "What's the most sobering thought that ever entered your mind?" He quickly responded, "My personal accountability to God."

## <u>43</u>

Gen. 31:7-Yet your father has cheated me and changed my wages ten times; however, <u>God did not allow him to hurt me</u>.

Gen. 31:9-Thus <u>God</u> has <u>taken</u> away your father's livestock and <u>given</u> them to me.

Gen. 32:9-10-<sup>9</sup> Jacob said, "O God of my father Abraham and God of my father Isaac, O LORD, who said to me, 'Return to your country and to your relatives, and I will prosper you,' <sup>10</sup> I am unworthy of all the lovingkindness and of all the <u>faithfulness</u> <u>which You have shown to Your servant</u>; for with my staff *only* I crossed this Jordan, and now <u>I have become two companies</u>.

1 Tim. 6:10-For the **love of money is a root** of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

1 Tim. 6:17-19-<sup>17</sup> Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, <u>who richly supplies us with all things to</u> <u>enjoy</u>. <sup>18</sup> *Instruct them* to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, <sup>19</sup> storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life indeed.

Matt. 27:57-When it was evening, there came a <u>rich man</u> from <u>Arimathea, named Joseph</u>, who himself had also become a <u>disciple</u> of Jesus.

Ps. 37:4-Delight yourself in the LORD; And He will give you the **desires** of your heart.
