1 Cor. 14:29-Let two or three prophets speak, and <u>let the others pass judgment</u>.

Deut. 13:1-5-"1 If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder, 2 and the sign or the wonder comes true, concerning which he spoke to you, saying, 'Let us go after other gods (whom you have not known) and let us serve them,' 3 you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams; for the Lord your God is testing you to find out if you love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. 4 You shall follow the Lord your God and fear Him; and you shall keep His commandments, listen to His voice, serve Him, and cling to Him. 5 But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has counseled rebellion against the Lord your God who brought you from the land of Egypt and redeemed you from the house of slavery, to seduce you from the way in which the Lord your God commanded you to walk. So you shall purge the evil from among you.

Rev. 2:2-I know your deeds and your toil and perseverance, and that you cannot tolerate evil men, and you put to the **test** those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them *to be-false*.

Num. 23:19-"God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent; Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?

Titus 1:2-in the hope of eternal life, which <u>God, who cannot</u> <u>lie</u>, promised long ages ago.

Heb. 6:18-so that by two unchangeable things in which it is **impossible for God to lie**, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.

1 Thess. 5:21(KJB)- Abstain from all **appearance** of evil.

"This verse does not subject Christians to abstain from every interpretation of evil as given by others. Rather, it is calling believers to abstain from what actually is evil."

John 3:3-5-3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is **born again** he cannot see the kingdom of God." 4 Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?" 5 Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is **born of water and the Spirit** he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

Titus 3:5-He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of <u>regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit</u>.

1 John 2:28-Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not **shrink away from Him in shame** at His coming.

1 John 3:2-3-² Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is. ³ And everyone who has this hope *fixed* on Him **purifies himself**, just as He is pure.

Philip. 1:6-For I am confident of this very thing, that <u>He who</u> began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

Gal. 5:16-But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

Greet Epaenetus, my beloved, who is the first convert to Christ from Asia. ⁶ Greet Mary, who has worked hard for you. ⁷ Greet Andronicus and Junias, my kinsmen and my fellow prisoners, who are outstanding among the apostles, who also were in Christ before me. ⁸ Greet Ampliatus, my beloved in the Lord. ⁹ Greet Urbanus, our fellow worker in Christ, and Stachys my beloved. 10 Greet Apelles, the approved in Christ. Greet those who are of the household of Aristobulus. 11 Greet Herodion, my kinsman. Greet those of the household of Narcissus, who are in the Lord. 12 Greet Tryphaena and Tryphosa, workers in the Lord. Greet Persis the beloved, who has worked hard in the Lord. ¹³ Greet Rufus, a choice man in the Lord, also his mother and mine. 14 Greet Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermes, Patrobas, Hermas and the brethren with them. ¹⁵ Greet Philologus and Julia, Nereus and his sister, and Olympas, and all the saints who are with them.

Rom. 16:16-<u>Greet</u> one another with a <u>holy kiss</u>. All the churches of Christ <u>greet</u> you.

2 Tim. 4:2-**preach the word**; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.

Gal. 5:1-It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery.
