Gen. 30:36-And he put a distance of **three days' journey** between himself and Jacob, and Jacob fed the rest of Laban's flocks.

Gen. 20:3-But **God came to Abimelech in a dream** of the night, and said to him, "Behold, you are a dead man because of the woman whom you have taken, for she is married."

Luke 15:22-23-²² But the father said to his slaves, 'Quickly bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet; ²³ and **bring the fattened calf, kill it, and let us eat and celebrate.**

Luke 15:25-Now his older son was in the field, and when he came and approached the house, he heard **music and dancing.**

Luke 15:29-30-²⁹ But he answered and said to his father, 'Look! For so many years I have been serving you and I have never neglected a command of yours; and *yet* you have never given me **a young goat**, so that I might celebrate with my friends; ³⁰ but when this son of yours came, who has devoured your wealth with prostitutes, you killed **the fattened calf** for him.'

Luke 22:48-But Jesus said to him, "Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a **kiss?**"

John 12:4-6-⁴ But Judas Iscariot, one of His disciples, who was intending to betray Him, said, ⁵ “Why was this perfume not sold for three hundred denarii and given to poor *people*?” ⁶ **Now he said this, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief**, and as he had the money box, he used to pilfer what was put into it.

Prov. 4:23 (NKJV) - Keep your **heart** with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life.

Isa. 43:10-11- ¹⁰ “You are My witnesses,” declares the LORD, “And My servant whom I have chosen, so that you may know and believe Me And understand that I am He. **Before Me there was no God formed, And there will be none after Me.** ¹¹ “I, even I, am the LORD, And **there is no savior besides Me.**

Isa. 44:6-Thus says the Lord, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the Lord of hosts: 'I am the first and I am the last, And **there is no God besides Me.**'

Lev. 19:32- 'You shall **rise up** before the gray-headed and honor the aged, and you shall revere your God; I am the Lord.

1 Kgs. 2:19-So Bathsheba went to King Solomon to speak to him for Adonijah. And the king **arose** to meet her, bowed before her, and sat on his throne; then he had a throne set for the king's mother, and she sat on his right.

Gal. 6:7-8-⁷ Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap. ⁸ For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Eph. 4:26-**Be angry, and yet do not sin**; do not let the sun go down on your anger.

Mark 3:5-After looking around at them with **anger**, grieved at their hardness of heart, He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched it out, and his hand was restored.

Gen. 4:5-8-⁵ but for Cain and for his offering He had no regard.

So Cain became very **angry** and his countenance fell.⁶ Then the Lord said to Cain, “Why are you **angry**? And why has your countenance fallen?⁷ If you do well, will not *your countenance* be lifted up? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it.”⁸ Cain told Abel his brother. And it came about when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.

Ezek. 34:2-3-² “Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel. Prophesy and say to those shepherds, ‘Thus says the Lord God, “**Woe, shepherds of Israel who have been feeding themselves!** Should not the shepherds feed the flock?³ **You eat the fat and clothe yourselves** with the wool, you slaughter the fat *sheep* without feeding the flock.

Acts 20:33-35-³³ **I have coveted no one’s silver or gold or clothes.** ³⁴ **You yourselves know that these hands ministered to my own needs and to the men who were with me.** ³⁵ In everything I showed you that by working hard in this manner you must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He Himself said, ‘It is more blessed to give than to receive.’”

2 Thess. 3:7-8-⁷ For you yourselves know how you ought to follow our example, because we did not act in an undisciplined manner among you, ⁸ **nor did we eat anyone’s bread without paying for it,** but with labor and hardship we *kept* working night and day so that we would not be a burden to any of you.

2 Corinthians 11:25-Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was stoned, three times I was shipwrecked, **a night and a day I have spent in the deep.**

Jas. 5:4-Behold, the pay of the laborers who mowed your fields, **and which has been withheld by you**, cries out *against you*; and the outcry of those who did the harvesting has reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth.

Deut. 24:15-You shall give him his **wages** on his day before the sun sets, for he is poor and sets his heart on it; so that he will not cry against you to the LORD and it become sin in you.
