1. Authorship

2 Thess. 1:1-**Paul**, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ

2 Thess. 3:17-I, <u>**Paul**</u>, write this greeting with my own hand, and this is a distinguishing mark in every letter; this is the way I write.

2. Audience

2 Thess. 1:1-Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, <u>**To the church of the**</u> <u>**Thessalonians**</u> in God <u>**our**</u> Father and the Lord Jesus Christ

3. Place of Writing

2 Thess. 1:1-**Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy**, To the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ

Acts 18:5-But when <u>Silas and Timothy</u> came down from Macedonia, <u>Paul</u> *began* devoting himself completely to the word, testifying to the Jews that Jesus was the Christ.

4. <u>Date</u>

1 Thess. 4:11-12-¹¹ and to make it your ambition to lead a quiet life and attend to your own *business* and <u>work with your hands</u>, just as we instructed you, ¹² so that you will behave properly toward outsiders and not be in any need.

1 Thess. 5:14-We urge you, brethren, <u>admonish the unruly</u>, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with everyone.

2 Thess. 3:6-15-6 Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you keep away from every brother who leads an <u>unruly life</u> and not according to the tradition which you received from us. ⁷ For you yourselves know how you ought to follow our example, because we did not act in an undisciplined manner among you, ⁸ nor did we eat anyone's bread without paying for it, but with labor and hardship we kept working night and day so that we would not be a burden to any of you; ⁹ not because we do not have the right to this, but in order to offer ourselves as a model for you, so that you would follow our example. ¹⁰ For even when we were with you, we used to give you this order: if anyone is not willing to work, then he is not to eat, either. ¹¹ For we hear that some among you are leading an **undisciplined life**, doing **no work** at all, but acting like **busybodies**. ¹² Now such persons we command and exhort in the Lord Jesus Christ to work in quiet fashion and eat their own bread. 13 But as for you, brethren, do not grow weary of doing good. 14 If anyone does not obey our instruction in this letter, take special note of that person and do not associate with him, so that he will be put to shame. ¹⁵ Yet do not regard him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.

5. Occasion

2 Thess. 2:2-that you not be quickly <u>shaken</u> from your composure or be disturbed either by <u>a spirit or a message</u> <u>or a letter as if from us</u>, to the effect that the <u>day of the</u> <u>Lord has come</u>.

1 Thess. 5:9-For God has not destined us for <u>wrath</u>, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.
