Acts 18:5-But when <u>Silas and Timothy</u> came down from Macedonia, <u>Paul</u> began devoting himself completely to the word, testifying to the Jews that Jesus was the Christ.

Romans 5:1-Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have **peace** with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Romans 5:10-For if while we were <u>enemies</u> we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

John 14:26–27-26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you. 27 "Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

Philippians 4:6–7-6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the **peace** of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Mark 4:35-41-35 On that day, when evening came, He said to them, "Let us go over to the other side." <sup>36</sup> Leaving the crowd, they took Him along with them in the boat, just as He was; and

other boats were with Him. <sup>37</sup> And there arose a fierce gale of wind, and the waves were breaking over the boat so much that the boat was already filling up. <sup>38</sup> Jesus Himself was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they woke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" <sup>39</sup> And He got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Hush, be still." And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm. <sup>40</sup> And He said to them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?" <sup>41</sup> They became very much afraid and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey Him?"

Gal. 2:20-I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but <u>Christ lives in me</u>; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Matt. 12:46-50-46 While He was still speaking to the crowds, behold, His <u>mother and brothers</u> were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him. 47 Someone said to Him, "Behold, Your <u>mother and Your brothers</u> are standing outside seeking to speak to You." 48 But Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, "Who is My <u>mother</u> and who are My <u>brothers</u>?" 49 And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, "Behold My <u>mother and My brothers</u>! 50 For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My <u>brother and sister and mother</u>."

Gal. 6:10-So then, while we have opportunity, let us do **good** to all people, and **especially to those who are of the household of the faith**.

Matt. 6:10- Your **kingdom** come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.

Acts 14:22-strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith, and saying, "Through many tribulations we must enter the **kingdom** of God.

Matt. 13:38-and the field is the world; and *as for* the good seed, these are the **sons of the kingdom**; and the tares are the sons of the evil *one*.

Gal. 4:7-Therefore you are no longer a slave, but **a son; and if a son, then an heir** through God.

Rev. 1:6-and He has made us to be <u>a kingdom</u>, <u>priests</u> to His God and Father—to Him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Rom. 2:5-But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are **storing up wrath** for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God.

<u>7</u>

Rev. 6:9-11- <sup>9</sup> When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God, and because of the testimony which they had maintained; <sup>10</sup> and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the

earth?" <sup>11</sup> And there was given to each of them a white robe; and they were told that they should rest for a little while longer, until *the number of* their fellow servants and their brethren who were to be killed even as they had been, would be completed also.

John 3:36-He who <u>believes</u> in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.

Matt. 7:21-23-21 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. 22 Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' 23 And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'

Rev. 20:10-And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet <u>are</u> also; and they will be tormented <u>day and night</u> forever and ever.

Rev. 21:27-and nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, **shall ever come into it**, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Rev. 22:15-<u>Outside</u> are the dogs and the sorcerers and the immoral persons and the murderers and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices lying.

Jude 14-And the <u>armies which are in heaven</u>, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, were following Him on white horses.

Rev. 19:14-It was also about these men that Enoch, in the seventh generation from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord came with <u>many thousands of His holy ones</u>.

## <u>11</u>

Heb. 11:6-And without <u>faith</u> it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must <u>believe</u> that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

Gal. 5:22-23- 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, **goodness**, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.
