<u>14-15</u>

1 Peter 1:4-to obtain an <u>inheritance</u> which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you.

<u>18</u>

Gen. 25:23-The LORD said to her, "Two nations are in your womb; And two peoples will be separated from your body; And one people shall be stronger than the other; And <u>the older shall</u> <u>serve the younger</u>."

Gen. 27:29-May peoples serve you, And nations bow down to you; <u>Be master of your brothers, And may your mother's sons</u> <u>bow down to you</u>. Cursed be those who curse you, And blessed be those who bless you.

2 Cor. 5:19-20-¹⁹ namely, that God was in Christ r<u>econciling</u> the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of <u>reconciliation</u>. ²⁰ Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be <u>reconciled</u> to God.

Rom. 5:10-For if while we were <u>enemies</u> we were <u>reconciled</u> to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been <u>reconciled</u>, we shall be saved by His life.

<u>19-20</u>
