Luke 5:15-16-<sup>15</sup> But the news about Him was spreading even farther, and large <u>crowds</u> were gathering to hear *Him* and to be healed of their sicknesses. <sup>16</sup> But Jesus Himself would *often* <u>slip</u> away to the wilderness and **pray**.

Eph. 6:12 (KJV)-For we <u>wrestle</u> not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Hos. 12:4-Yes, <u>he wrestled with the angel and prevailed; He wept and sought His favor</u>. He found Him at Bethel And there He spoke with us.

Col. 4:12-Epaphras, who is one of your number, a bondslave of Jesus Christ, sends you his greetings, always <u>laboring earnestly</u> <u>[agōnizomai]</u> for you in his prayers, that you may stand perfect and fully assured in all the will of God.

#### <u>25</u>

2 Peter 2:11-whereas <u>angels who are greater in might and</u> <u>power</u> do not bring a reviling judgment against them before the Lord.

Matt. 28:2-And behold, a severe earthquake had occurred, for an **angel of the Lord** descended from heaven and came and **rolled away the stone** and sat upon it.

- Isa. 37:36-Then <u>the angel of the LORD</u> went out and <u>struck</u> <u>185,000</u> in the camp of the Assyrians; and when men arose early in the morning, behold, all of these were dead.
- Gen. 15:9-11-9 So He said to him, "Bring Me a three-year-old heifer, and a three-year-old female goat, and a three year old ram, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon." <sup>10</sup> Then he brought all these to Him and cut them in two, and laid each half opposite the other; but he did not cut the birds. <sup>11</sup> The birds of prey came down upon the carcasses, and Abram drove them away.
- Gen. 15:17-21-<sup>17</sup> It came about when the sun had set, that it was very dark, and behold, *there appeared* a smoking oven and a flaming torch which passed between these pieces. <sup>18</sup> On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, "To your descendants I have given this land, From the river of Egypt as far as the great river, the river Euphrates: <sup>19</sup> the Kenite and the Kenizzite and the Kadmonite <sup>20</sup> and the Hittite and the Perizzite and the Rephaim <sup>21</sup> and the Amorite and the Canaanite and the Girgashite and the Jebusite."
- John 1:14-And <u>the Word became flesh</u>, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.
- Isa. 6:7-He **touched** my mouth *with it* and said, "Behold, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven."
- 2 Cor. 12:7-10-<sup>7</sup> Because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, for this reason, to keep me from exalting myself, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, a messenger of Satan
