Gen. 32:6-Then the messengers returned to Jacob, saying, “We came to your brother Esau, and he also is coming to meet you, and **four hundred men** are with him.”

## 2

Prov. 27:12-A prudent man sees evil and hides himself, the naive proceed and pay the penalty.

Gen. 41:46-49-<sup>46</sup> Now Joseph was thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh, king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh and went through all the land of Egypt. <sup>47</sup> During the seven years of plenty the land brought forth abundantly. <sup>48</sup> **So he gathered all the food of these seven years which occurred in the land of Egypt and placed the food in the cities**; he placed in every city the food from its own surrounding fields. <sup>49</sup> Thus Joseph stored up grain in great abundance like the sand of the sea, until he stopped measuring *it*, for it was beyond measure.

Eph. 4:32-Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, **forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.**

Eph. 4:26-27- <sup>26</sup> BE ANGRY, AND *yet* DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger, <sup>27</sup> and **do not give the devil an opportunity.**

Matt. 18:34-And his lord, moved with anger, handed him over to the **torturers** until he should repay all that was owed him.

Philip. 4:6-7-<sup>6</sup> **Be anxious for nothing**, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; <sup>7</sup> and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Matt. 6:27-Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?

Gen. 25:23-The LORD said to her, "Two nations are in your womb; And two peoples will be separated from your body; And one people shall be stronger than the other; And **the older shall serve the younger.**"

Gen. 27:29-May peoples serve you, And nations bow down to you; **Be master of your brothers, And may your mother's sons bow down to you.** Cursed be those who curse you, And blessed be those who bless you.

Eph. 3:20-Now to Him who is **able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think**, according to the power that works in us

1 Kings 3:5-14-<sup>5</sup> At Gibeon the Lord appeared to Solomon in a dream by night; and God said, “**Ask! What shall I give you?**”  
<sup>6</sup> And Solomon said: “You have shown great mercy to Your servant David my father, because he walked before You in truth, in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with You; You have continued this great kindness for him, and You have given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day. <sup>7</sup> Now, O Lord my God, You have made Your servant king instead of my father David, but I am a little child; I do not know how to go out or come in. <sup>8</sup> And Your servant is in the midst of Your people whom You have chosen, a great people, too numerous to be numbered or counted. <sup>9</sup> Therefore **give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?**”  
<sup>10</sup> **The speech pleased the Lord, that Solomon had asked this thing.** <sup>11</sup> **Then God said to him: “Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice,** <sup>12</sup> **behold, I have done according to your words; see, I have given you a wise and understanding heart, so that there**

**has not been anyone like you before you, nor shall any like you arise after you.** <sup>13</sup> **And I have also given you what you have not asked: both riches and honor, so that there shall not be anyone like you among the kings all your days.** <sup>14</sup> So if you walk in My ways, to keep My statutes and My commandments, as your father David walked, then I will lengthen your days.

Acts 28:10- They also honored us with many marks of respect; and when we were setting sail, **they supplied us with all we needed.**
