Gen. 30:20-21-²⁰ Then **Leah** said, “God has endowed me with a good gift; now my husband will dwell with me, because I have borne him six sons.” So she named him Zebulun. ²¹ Afterward she bore a daughter and named her **Dinah**.

Gen. 9:20-26-²⁰ Then Noah began farming and planted a vineyard. ²¹ He drank of the wine and became drunk, and uncovered himself inside his tent. ²² **Ham, the father of Canaan**, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brothers outside. ²³ But Shem and Japheth took a garment and laid it upon both their shoulders and walked backward and covered the nakedness of their father; and their faces were turned away, so that they did not see their father’s nakedness. ²⁴ When Noah awoke from his wine, he knew what his youngest son had done to him. ²⁵ So he said, “Cursed be **Canaan**; A servant of servants He shall be to his brothers.” ²⁶ He also said, “Blessed be the LORD, The God of Shem; And let **Canaan** be his servant.

Gen. 15:13-God said to Abram, “Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, where they will be **enslaved and oppressed** four hundred years.

2 Sam. 13:14-15-¹⁴ However, he would not listen to her; since he was stronger than she, he violated her and lay with her. ¹⁵ Then **Amnon hated her with a very great hatred; for the hatred**

with which he hated her was greater than the love with which he had loved her. And Amnon said to her, “Get up, go away!”

1 Cor. 13:4-7-⁴ Love is patient, love is kind *and* is not jealous; love does not brag *and* is not arrogant, ⁵ does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong *suffered*, ⁶ does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; ⁷ bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Judges 14:2-So he came back and told his father and mother, “I saw a woman in Timnah, one of the daughters of the Philistines; now therefore, **get her for me as a wife.**”

2 Sam. 13:12-But she answered him, “No, my brother, do not violate me, **for such a thing is not done in Israel**; do not do this disgraceful thing!

Deut. 7:1-4-¹ When the LORD your God brings you into the land where you are entering to possess it, and **clears away many nations before you, the Hittites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Canaanites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites**, seven nations greater and stronger than you, ² and when the LORD your God delivers them before you and you defeat them, then you shall utterly destroy them. You shall make no covenant with them and show no favor to them. ³ Furthermore, **you shall not intermarry with them; you shall not give your daughters to their sons, nor shall you take their daughters for your sons.** ⁴ For they will turn your sons away from following Me to serve other gods; then the

anger of the LORD will be kindled against you and He will quickly destroy you.

Gen. 19:1-Now the two angels came to Sodom in the evening as Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he rose to meet them and bowed down with his face to the ground.

Matt. 6:24-No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. **You cannot serve God and wealth.**

1 Tim. 6:10-For the **love of money** is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Josh. 8:30-35-³⁰ Then Joshua built an altar to the LORD, the God of Israel, in Mount Ebal, ³¹ just as Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded the sons of Israel, as it is written in the book of the law of Moses, an altar of uncut stones on which no man had wielded an iron *tool*; and they offered burnt offerings on it to the LORD, and sacrificed peace offerings. ³² He wrote there on the stones a copy of the law of Moses, which he had written, in the presence of the sons of Israel. ³³ All Israel with their elders and officers and their judges were standing on both sides of the ark before the Levitical priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD, the stranger as well as the native. Half of them *stood* in front of Mount Gerizim and half of them in front of

Mount Ebal, just as Moses the servant of the LORD had given command at first to bless the people of Israel. ³⁴ Then afterward he read all the words of the law, the blessing and the curse, according to all that is written in the book of the law. ³⁵ There was not a word of all that Moses had commanded which Joshua did not read before all the assembly of Israel with the women and the little ones and the strangers who were living among them.

Exod. 21:23-24-²³ But if there is *any further* injury, then you shall appoint *as a penalty* **life for life, ²⁴ eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, ²⁵ burn for burn, wound for wound, bruise for bruise.**

Gen. 49:5-7-⁵ **“Simeon and Levi are brothers;** Their swords are implements of **violence.** ⁶ “Let my soul not enter into their council; Let not my glory be united with their assembly; Because in their **anger they slew men, And in their self-will** they lamed oxen. ⁷ “Cursed be **their anger, for it is fierce;** And **their wrath, for it is cruel.** I will disperse them in Jacob And scatter them in Israel.

Matt. 19:28-And Jesus said to them, “Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of Man will sit on His glorious throne, you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging **the twelve tribes of Israel.**”

1 John 2:28-Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and **not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming.**

Rev. 3:11- I am coming quickly; hold fast what you have, **so that no one will take your crown.**
