1 Cor. 13:4-7-⁴Love is patient, love is kind *and* is not jealous; love does not brag *and* is not arrogant, ⁵does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong *suffered*, ⁶does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; ⁷bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Deut. 7:1-4-¹ When the LORD your God brings you into the land where you are entering to possess it, and **clears away many nations before you, the Hittites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Canaanites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites**, seven nations greater and stronger than you, ²and when the LORD your God delivers them before

you and you defeat them, then you shall utterly destroy them. You shall make no covenant with them and show no favor to them. ³ Furthermore, **you shall not intermarry with them; you shall not give your daughters to their sons, nor shall you take their daughters for your sons.** ⁴ For they will turn your sons away from following Me to serve other gods; then the anger of the LORD will be kindled against you and He will quickly destroy you.

Gen. 32:10-I am unworthy of all the lovingkindness and of all the faithfulness which You have shown to Your servant; **for with my staff only I crossed this Jordan, and now I have become two companies.**

Matt. 6:24-No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. **You cannot serve God and wealth.**

1 Tim. 6:10-For the **love of money** is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Matt. 26:52-Then Jesus said to him, “Put your sword back into its place; for all **those who take up the sword shall perish by the sword.**”

Gal. 6:7-8- ⁷ Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for **whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.** ⁸ For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Prov. 13:15 (KJV)-Good understanding giveth favour: but **the way of transgressors is hard.**

Josh. 8:30-35-³⁰ Then Joshua built an altar to the LORD, the God of Israel, in Mount Ebal, ³¹ just as Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded the sons of Israel, as it is written in the book of the law of Moses, an altar of uncut stones on which no man had wielded an iron *tool*; and they offered burnt offerings on it to the LORD, and sacrificed peace offerings. ³² He wrote there

on the stones a copy of the law of Moses, which he had written, in the presence of the sons of Israel. ³³ All Israel with their elders and officers and their judges were standing on both sides of the ark before the Levitical priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD, the stranger as well as the native. Half of them *stood* in front of Mount Gerizim and half of them in front of Mount Ebal, just as Moses the servant of the LORD had given command at first to bless the people of Israel. ³⁴ Then afterward he read all the words of the law, the blessing, and the curse, according to all that is written in the book of the law. ³⁵ There was not a word of all that Moses had commanded which Joshua did not read before all the assembly of Israel with the women and the little ones and the strangers who were living among them.

31

Exod. 21:23-24-²³ But if there is *any further* injury, then you shall appoint *as a penalty* **life for life, ²⁴ eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, ²⁵ burn for burn, wound for wound, bruise for bruise.**

Gen. 49:5-7-⁵ “**Simeon and Levi are brothers;** Their swords are implements of **violence.** ⁶“Let my soul not enter into their council; Let not my glory be united with their assembly; Because in their **anger they slew men, And in their self-will** they lamed oxen. ⁷“Cursed be **their anger, for it is fierce;** And **their wrath, for it is cruel.** I will disperse them in Jacob And scatter them in Israel.

Matt. 19:28-And Jesus said to them, “Truly I say to you, that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of Man

will sit on His glorious throne, you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging **the twelve tribes of Israel.**”

1 John 2:28-Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and **not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming.**

Rev. 3:11- I am coming quickly; hold fast what you have, **so that no one will take your crown.**
