Acts 3:11-While he was clinging to Peter and John, all the people ran together to them at the so-called **portico of Solomon**, full of amazement.

Gal. 3:13-Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, “CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A **TREE**”—

Acts 10:39-We are witnesses of all the things He did both in the land of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They also put Him to death by hanging Him on a **cross**.

1 Pet. 2:24-and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the **cross**, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

Acts 3:15-but put to death the Prince of life, *the one* whom God raised from the dead, *a fact* to which we are witnesses.

Acts 3:19-21- ¹⁹ Therefore repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from

It would eat of his bread and drink of

Luke 2:46-Then, after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of **the teachers**, both listening to them and asking them questions.
