Today I show kindness to the house of Saul your father, to his brothers and to his friends, and have not delivered you into the hands of David; and yet today you charge me with a guilt concerning the woman.

2 Sam. 12:8- I also gave you your master’s house **and your master’s wives into your care, and I gave you the house of Israel and Judah**; and if *that had been* too little, I would have added to you many more things like these!

2 Sam. 16:20-22-<sup>20</sup> Then Absalom said to Ahithophel, “Give your advice.
