Rev. 19:20-And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone.

Luke 22:42-saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet **not My will, but Yours be done**."

Rev. 6:1-4-¹ Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come." ¹ I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer. ³ When He broke the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come." ⁴ And another, a red horse, went out; and to him who sat on it, it was granted to take peace from the earth, and that men would slay one another; and a great sword was given to him.

John 17:12-While I was with them, I was keeping them in Your name which You have given Me; and I guarded them and not one of them perished but the **son of perdition**, so that the Scripture would be fulfilled.

John 13:27-After the morsel, **Satan then entered into him**. Therefore Jesus said to him, "What you do, do quickly."

Rev. 12:9-And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the

whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

Rv. 13:4-they worshiped the <u>dragon because he gave his</u> <u>authority to the beast</u>; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who is able to wage war with him?"

Dan. 8:5-8-5 While I was observing, behold, a male goat was coming from the west over the surface of the entire earth without touching the ground; and the goat *had* a prominent horn between his eyes. ⁶ He came up to the ram that had the two horns, which I had seen standing in front of the canal and rushed at him in his mighty wrath. ⁷ And I saw him come up beside the ram, and he was enraged at him; and he struck the ram and smashed his two horns, and the ram had no strength to withstand him. So, he hurled him to the ground and trampled on him, and there was no one to rescue the ram from his power. ⁸ Then the male goat made himself exceedingly great. But once he became powerful, **the large horn was broken; and in its place four prominent horns came up toward the four winds of heaven**.

Dan. 11:3-4-³ And a mighty king will arise, and he will rule with great authority and do as he pleases. ⁴ But as soon as he has arisen, his kingdom will be broken up and parceled out toward the <u>four points of the compass</u>, though not to his *own* descendants, nor according to his authority which he wielded, for his sovereignty will be uprooted and *given* to others besides them.

Dan. 12:11-From the time that the <u>regular sacrifice is abolished</u> and the abomination of desolation is set up, there will be 1,290 days.

Mark 13:14-But when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION **standing where it should not be** (let the reader understand), then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains.

Rev. 11:1-2-¹ Then there was given me a measuring rod like a staff; and someone said, "Get up and measure the temple of God and the altar, and those who worship in it. ² Leave out the court which is outside the <u>temple</u> and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread under foot the holy city for forty-two months.

Rev. 13:15-And it was given to him to give breath to **the image** of the beast, so that the image of the beast would even speak and cause as many as do not worship the image of the beast to be killed.

Isa. 14:12-15-¹² "How you have fallen from heaven, O star of the morning, son of the dawn! You have been cut down to the earth, You who have weakened the nations! ¹³ "But you said in your heart, 'I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, And I will sit on the mount of assembly In the recesses of the north. ¹⁴ 'I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; <u>I will make myself like the Most High</u>.' ¹⁵ "Nevertheless you will be thrust down to Sheol, To the recesses of the pit.

Gen. 3:5-For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and **you will be like God**, knowing good and evil.
