Job 2:11-Now when Job's three friends heard of all this adversity that had come upon him, they came each one from his own place, **Eliphaz the Temanite**, Bildad the Shuhite and Zophar the Naamathite; and they made an appointment together to come to sympathize with him and comfort him.

### <u>12</u>

Exod. 17:8-16-8 Then Amalek came and fought against Israel at Rephidim. 9 So Moses said to Joshua, "Choose men for us and go out, fight against Amalek. Tomorrow I will station myself on the top of the hill with the staff of God in my hand." <sup>10</sup> Joshua did as Moses told him, and fought against Amalek; and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill. <sup>11</sup> So it came about when Moses held his hand up, that Israel prevailed, and when he let his hand down, Amalek prevailed. 12 But Moses' hands were heavy. Then they took a stone and put it under him, and he sat on it; and Aaron and Hur supported his hands, one on one side and one on the other. Thus, his hands were steady until the sun set. 13 So Joshua overwhelmed Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword. <sup>14</sup> Then the LORD said to Moses, "Write this in a book as a memorial and recite it to Joshua, that I will utterly blot out the memory of **Amalek** from under heaven." <sup>15</sup> Moses built an altar and named it The LORD is My Banner; 16 and he said, "The LORD has sworn; the LORD will have war against **Amalek** from generation to generation."

Judges 3:13-And he gathered to himself the sons of Ammon and **Amalek**; and he went and defeated Israel, and they possessed the city of the palm trees.

1 Sam. 14:48-He [Saul] acted valiantly and defeated the **Amalekites**, and delivered Israel from the hands of those who plundered them.

### <u>14</u>

Judges 2:10-All that generation also were gathered to their fathers; and there arose another generation after them who did not know the LORD, nor yet the work which He had done for Israel.

Eph. 6:4-Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

# <u>31</u>

Gen. 17:6-I will make you exceedingly fruitful, and I will make nations of you, and **kings** will come forth from you.

Gen. 17:16-I will bless her, and indeed I will give you a son by her. Then I will bless her, and she shall be *a mother of* nations; **kings** of peoples will come from her."

Gen. 35:11-God also said to him, "I am God Almighty; Be fruitful and multiply; A nation and a company of nations shall come from you, And **kings** shall come forth from you."

Deut. 17:14-20-<sup>14</sup> "When you enter the land which the LORD your God gives you, and you possess it and live in it, and you say, 'I will set a **king** over me like all the nations who are around me,' <sup>15</sup> you shall surely set a **king** over you whom the LORD your God chooses, *one* from among your countrymen you shall set as **king** over yourselves; you may not put a foreigner over

yourselves who is not your countryman. <sup>16</sup> Moreover, he shall not multiply horses for himself, nor shall he cause the people to return to Egypt to multiply horses, since the LORD has said to you, 'You shall never again return that way.' <sup>17</sup> He shall not multiply wives for himself, or else his heart will turn away; nor shall he greatly increase silver and gold for himself. <sup>18</sup> "Now it shall come about when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, he shall write for himself a copy of this law on a scroll in the presence of the Levitical priests. <sup>19</sup> It shall be with him and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, by carefully observing all the words of this law and these statutes, <sup>20</sup> that his heart may not be lifted up above his countrymen and that he may not turn aside from the commandment, to the right or the left, so that he and his sons may continue long in his kingdom in the midst of Israel.

Deut. 28:36-The LORD will bring you and your **king**, whom you set over you, to a nation which neither you nor your fathers have known, and there you shall serve other gods, wood and stone.

### **39**

Num. 20:14-21-<sup>14</sup> From Kadesh Moses then sent messengers to the <u>king of Edom</u>: "Thus your brother Israel has said, 'You know all the hardship that has befallen us; <sup>15</sup> that our fathers went down to Egypt, and we stayed in Egypt a long time, and the Egyptians treated us and our fathers badly. <sup>16</sup> But when we cried out to the LORD, He heard our voice and sent an angel and brought us out from Egypt; now behold, we are at Kadesh, a town on the edge of your territory. <sup>17</sup> Please let us pass through your land. We will not pass through field or through vineyard; we will not even drink water from a well. We will go along the king's

highway, not turning to the right or left, until we pass through your territory." <sup>18</sup> Edom, however, said to him, "You shall not pass through us, or I will come out with the sword against you." <sup>19</sup> Again, the sons of Israel said to him, "We will go up by the highway, and if I and my livestock do drink any of your water, then I will pay its price. Let me only pass through on my feet, nothing *else*." <sup>20</sup> But he said, "You shall not pass through." And Edom came out against him with a heavy force and with a strong hand. <sup>21</sup> Thus Edom refused to allow Israel to pass through his territory; so Israel turned away from him.
