Judges 8:22-26- ²² Then the men of Israel said to Gideon, “Rule over us, both you and your son, also your son’s son, for you have delivered us from the hand of **Midian**.” ²³ But Gideon said to them, “I will not

rule over you, nor shall my son rule over you; the Lord shall rule over you.”²⁴ Yet Gideon said to them, “I would request of you, that each of you give me an earring from his spoil.” (For they had gold earrings, because they were Ishmaelites.)²⁵ They said, “We will surely give *them*.” So they spread out a garment, and every one of them threw an earring there from his spoil.²⁶ The weight of the gold earrings that he requested was 1,700 *shekels* of gold, besides the crescent ornaments and the pendants and the purple robes which *were* on the kings of **Midian**, and besides the neck bands that *were* on their camels’ necks.
