Gen. 35:27-Jacob came to his father Isaac at Mamre of Kiriath-arba (that is, **Hebron**), where Abraham and Isaac had resided.

## <u>13</u>

Heb. 10:5-9-Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me; in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure. Then I said, 'Behold, <u>I have come to do your will</u>, O God, as it is written of me in the scroll of the book." When he said above, "You have neither desired <u>nor taken pleasure in sacrifices</u> and offerings and burnt offerings and sin offerings" (these are offered according to the law), then he added, "Behold, <u>I have come to do your will</u>." He does away with the first in order to establish the second.

# <u>14</u>

Gen. 37:2b-Joseph, being seventeen years old, was pasturing the flock with his brothers. He was a boy with the sons of Bilhah and Zilpah, his father's wives. **And Joseph brought a bad report of them to their father**.

Gen. 35:27-Jacob came to his father Isaac at Mamre of Kiriath-arba (that is, **Hebron**), where Abraham and Isaac had resided.

#### 15

Heb. 1:14-Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to **serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation**?

Heb. 13:2-Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained <u>angels</u> unawares.

Jer. 11:9-Again the LORD said to me, "A **conspiracy** exists among the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem."

## <u>20</u>

Luke 23:12-And so <u>Herod and Pilate</u> became <u>friends</u> with one another that very day; for previously, they had been <u>enemies</u> toward each other.

John 15:18-19- If the <u>world</u> hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you. If you were of the <u>world</u>, the <u>world</u> would love you as its own; but because you are not of the <u>world</u>, but I chose you out of the <u>world</u>, therefore the world hates you.

1 John 2:15-17- Do not love the <u>world</u> or the things in the <u>world</u>. If anyone loves the <u>world</u>, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the <u>world</u>—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the <u>world</u>. And the <u>world</u> is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.

#### <u>22</u>

Gen. 37:29-30-When Reuben returned to the pit and saw that <u>Joseph</u> was not in the pit, he tore his clothes and returned to his brothers and said, "The boy is gone, and I, where shall I go?"

#### <u>23</u>

John 19:23-24- <sup>23</sup> Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, **took His outer garments** and made four parts: a part to each soldier, and the tunic *also*; but the tunic was seamless, woven in one piece. <sup>24</sup> So they said to one another, "Let's not tear it, but cast lots for

it, to decide whose it shall be." This happened so that the Scripture would be fulfilled: "They divided My garments among themselves, and they cast lots for My clothing." Therefore the soldiers did these things.

#### <u>24</u>

Jas. 1:9-11-Let the lowly brother boast in his exaltation, and the rich in his humiliation, because like a flower of the grass he will pass away. For the sun rises with its scorching heat and withers the grass; its flower falls, and its beauty perishes. So also will the rich man fade away in the midst of his pursuits.

## <u>27</u>

Rom. 9:3 (NKJV)-For I could wish that I myself were accursed from Christ for my **brethren**, my countrymen according to the flesh.

Matt. 25:40-The King will answer and say to them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it to one of these **brothers** of Mine, *even* the least *of them*, you did it to Me.'

## <u>28</u>

Gen. 25:1-2-<sup>1</sup> Now Abraham took another wife, whose name was **Keturah**. <sup>2</sup> She bore to him Zimran and Jokshan and Medan and **Midian** and Ishbak and Shuah.

Judges 8:22-26-<sup>22</sup> Then the men of Israel said to Gideon, "Rule over us, both you and your son, also your son's son, for you have delivered us from the hand of <u>Midian</u>." <sup>23</sup> But Gideon said to them, "I will not rule over you, nor shall my son rule over you; the Lord shall rule over you." <sup>24</sup> Yet Gideon said to them, "I would request of you, that each of you give me an earring from his spoil." (For they had gold earrings, because they were Ishmaelites.) <sup>25</sup> They said, "We will surely

give *them*." So they spread out a garment, and every one of them threw an earring there from his spoil. <sup>26</sup> The weight of the gold earrings that he requested was 1,700 *shekels* of gold, besides the crescent ornaments and the pendants and the purple robes which *were* on the kings of <u>Midian</u>, and besides the neck bands that *were* on their camels' necks.

Zech. 11:12-I said to them, "If it is good in your sight, give *me* my wages; but if not, never mind!" So they weighed out **thirty shekels of silver** as my wages.

## <u>29</u>

Job 1:20-Then Job arose and **tore his robe** and shaved his head, and he fell to the ground and worshiped.

Matt. 26:65-Then the high priest **tore his robes** and said, "He has blasphemed! What further need do we have of witnesses? Behold, you have now heard the blasphemy.

## <u>31</u>

Gal. 6:7-8-<sup>7</sup> Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap. <sup>8</sup> For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Num. 32:23-But if you will not do so, behold, you have sinned against the Lord, and be sure **your sin will find you out**.

## <u>35</u>

Gen. 46:7-His sons and his grandsons with him, <u>his daughters and his granddaughters</u>, and all his descendants he brought with him to Egypt.

Gen. 46:15-These are the sons of Leah, whom she bore to Jacob in Paddan-aram, with <u>his daughter Dinah</u>; all his sons and <u>his daughters</u> *numbered* thirty-three.

#### <u>36</u>

Gen. 39:1- Now Joseph had been taken down to **Egypt**; and **Potiphar**, an Egyptian officer of Pharaoh, the captain of the bodyguard, bought him from the Ishmaelites, who had taken him down there.
