Matt. 27:32-As they were coming out, they found a man of <u>Cyrene</u> named Simon, whom they pressed into service to bear His cross.

## <u>10</u>

Mark 13:11-When they arrest you and hand you over, do not worry beforehand about what you are to say, but say whatever is given you in that hour; for it is not you who speak, but it is the **Holy Spirit**.

Matt. 22:46-No one was <u>able</u> to answer Him a word, nor did anyone <u>dare</u> from that day on to ask Him another question.

1 Tim. 3:9-but holding to the **mystery of the faith** with a clear conscience.

Titus 1:9-holding fast the faithful word which is in accordance with the teaching, so that he will be able both to exhort in sound doctrine and to **refute** those who contradict.

## <u>11</u>

Jer. 11:9-Again the LORD said to me, "A **conspiracy** exists among the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem."

Luke 23:12-And so <u>Herod and Pilate</u> became <u>friends</u> with one another that very day; for previously, they had been <u>enemies</u> toward each other.

Lev. 24:16-Moreover, the one who <u>blasphemes the name of</u> the Lord shall surely be put to death; all the congregation shall certainly stone him. The alien as well as the native, when he <u>blasphemes the Name</u>, shall be put to death.

Matt. 26:60-61-<sup>60</sup> They did not find any, even though many false witnesses came forward. But later on two came forward, <sup>61</sup> and said, "This man stated, 'I am able to **destroy the temple** of God and to rebuild it in three days."

## <u>14</u>

Matt. 5:17-Do not think that I came to abolish the <u>Law</u> or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to <u>fulfill</u>.
