Acts 2:37-Now when they heard *this*, they were **pierced** to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Brethren, what shall we do?”

Acts 5:33-But when they heard this, they were **cut to the quick** and intended to kill them.

Heb. 4:12-For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and **piercing** as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Matt. 13:50-and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and **gnashing of teeth**.

Dut. 17:6-7- ⁶ On the evidence of two witnesses or three witnesses, he who is to die shall be put to death; he shall not be put to death on the evidence of one witness. ⁷ **The hand of the witnesses shall be first against him to put him to death,** and

afterward the hand of all the people. So you shall purge the evil from your midst.

Matt. 27:50-51- ⁵⁰ And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and **yielded up His spirit.** ⁵¹ And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth shook and the rocks were split.

Gen. 35:18-It came about **as her soul was departing (for she died)**, that she named him Ben-oni; but his father called him Benjamin.

2 Cor. 5:8- we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be **absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.**

Philip 1:21-23- ²¹ For to me, to live is Christ and **to die is gain.** ²² But if *I am* to live *on* in the flesh, this *will mean* fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. ²³ But I am hard-pressed from both *directions*, having the desire **to depart and be with Christ, for that is very much better.**

Luke 22:41-And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and He **knelt down** and *began* to pray.

Dan. 6:10-Now when Daniel knew that the document was signed, he entered his house (now in his roof chamber he had windows open toward Jerusalem); and he continued **kneeling** on his knees three times a day, praying and giving thanks before his God, as he had been doing previously.

Luke 23:34-But Jesus was saying, “**Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.**” And they cast lots, dividing up His garments among themselves.
