Gen. 37:2-These are the records of the generations of Jacob. Joseph, when <u>seventeen years of age</u>, was pasturing the flock with his brothers while he was still a youth, along with the sons of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives. And Joseph brought back a bad report about them to their father.

Dan. 6:3-4-³ Then this <u>Daniel began distinguishing</u> <u>himself</u> among the commissioners and satraps because he possessed an extraordinary spirit, and the king planned to appoint him over the entire kingdom. Then the commissioners and satraps began trying to <u>find a ground of accusation</u> against Daniel in regard to government affairs; but they could find no ground of accusation or *evidence of* corruption, inasmuch as he was faithful, and no negligence or corruption was *to be* found in him.
