Rom. 1:18-32-¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven unrighteousness all ungodliness and against of men who <u>suppress</u> the truth in unrighteousness, ¹⁹ because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them.²⁰ For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes. His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.²¹ For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened.²² Professing to be wise, they became fools, ²³ and <u>exchanged</u> the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures. ²⁴ Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them.²⁵ For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. ²⁶ For this reason God gave them over to degrading passions; for their women exchanged the natural function for that which is unnatural,²⁷ and in the same way also the men **abandoned** the natural function of the woman and **burned** in their desire toward one another, men with men committing indecent acts and receiving in their own persons the due penalty of their error. ²⁸ And just as they did <u>not</u> see fit to <u>acknowledge</u> God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper, ²⁹ being filled with all

unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; *they are* gossips,³⁰ slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, ³¹ without understanding, untrustworthy, unloving, unmerciful; ³² and although they know the ordinance of God, that those who practice such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them.

Rev. 19:11-And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it is called Faithful and <u>**True**</u>, and in righteousness He judges and wages war.

John 14:6-Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and <u>the truth</u>, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me."

John 8:32-and you will know <u>the truth</u>, and <u>the truth</u> will make you free.

1 Tim. 3:15-but in case I am delayed, I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and support of <u>the truth</u>.

Luke 16:28-31-²⁸ for I have five brothers—in order that he may warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.' ²⁹ But Abraham said, 'They have <u>Moses and the</u> <u>Prophets</u>; let them hear them.' ³⁰ But he said, 'No, father Abraham, but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent!' ³¹ But he said to him, 'If they do not listen to <u>Moses and</u> <u>the Prophets</u>, they will not be persuaded even if someone rises from the dead.'"

2 Tim. 3:15-and that from childhood you have known the <u>sacred</u> <u>writings</u> which are able to give you the <u>wisdom that leads</u> <u>to salvation</u> through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Jas. 1:18-In the exercise of His will He **brought us forth** by **the word of truth**, so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures.

1 Pet. 1:23-for you have been **born again** not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring **word of God**.

1 Kgs. 22:19-23-19 Micaiah said, "Therefore, hear the word of the Lord. I saw the Lord sitting on His throne, and all the host of standing by Him on His right and heaven on His left. ²⁰ The Lord said, 'Who will entice Ahab to go up and fall at Ramoth-Gilead?' And one said this while another said that. ²¹ Then a spirit came forward and stood before the Lord and said, 'I will entice him.' ²² The Lord said to him, 'How?' And he said, 'I will go out and be a deceiving spirit in the mouth of all his prophets.' Then He said, 'You are to entice him and also prevail. Go and do so.'23 Now therefore, behold, the Lord has put a deceiving spirit in the mouth of all these your prophets; and the Lord has proclaimed disaster against you."

Matt. 10:28-Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

John 5:43-I have come in My Father's name, and <u>you do not</u> <u>receive Me</u>; if another comes in his own name, <u>you will receive</u> <u>him</u>.

Rev. 6:1-4-¹Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come." ²I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out <u>conquering and to conquer</u>. ³When He broke the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come." ⁴And another, a red horse, went out; and to him who sat on it, it was granted to <u>take peace from the earth</u>, and that men would slay one another; and a great sword was given to him.

Rev. 13:4-they **worshiped** the dragon because he gave his authority to the beast; and they **worshiped** the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who is able to wage war with him?"

Rev. 13:8-All who dwell on the earth will **worship** him, everyone whose name has not been written from the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who has been slain.

Rev. 13:12-He exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence. And he makes the earth and those who dwell in it to **worship** the first beast, whose fatal wound was healed.

Rev. 13:15- And it was given to him to give breath to the image of the beast, so that the image of the beast would even speak and cause as many as do not **worship** the image of the beast to be killed.

Acts 17:31-because <u>He has fixed a day in which He will</u> <u>judge the world</u> in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead.

The great American statesman Daniel Webster was once asked, "What's the most sobering thought that ever entered your mind?" He quickly responded, "<u>My personal accountability to</u> <u>God</u>."

Heb. 11:6-And <u>without faith it is impossible to please Him</u>, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

John 3:18-He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, **because he has not believed** in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

John 5:40-and you are <u>unwilling</u> to come to Me so that you may have life.

John 3:19-21-¹⁹ This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and <u>men loved the darkness rather than the Light</u>, for their deeds were evil. ²⁰ For everyone who does evil hates the Light and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be exposed. ²¹ But he who practices the truth comes to the Light, so that his deeds may be manifested as having been wrought in God.

Heb. 11:25-choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the **passing pleasures of sin**.

"Some teach from these verses that those who reject Christ before the rapture will have no opportunity of receiving Him in the Tribulation. However, this view forces the text to answer a question that it is not dealing with. These verses do not deal with the question of who can be saved during the tribulation period. Rather, they are dealing with how the lawless one will gain control of the world during that time and why God will allow the earth's population to be deluded. These verses are speaking of unbelievers in the Tribulation. The context pertains to Daniel's 70th Week and not issues related to the church age."
