Gen. 15:11-The **birds** of prey came down upon the carcasses, and Abram drove them away.

Dan. 4:12-'Its foliage *was* beautiful and its fruit abundant, And in it *was* food for all. The beasts of the field found shade under it, And the **birds** of the sky dwelt in its branches, And all living creatures fed themselves from it.

39:17-19-<sup>17</sup> "Son of Ezek. this man. what the 1S Sovereign Lord says: Call out to every kind of bird and all the wild animals: 'Assemble and come together from all around to the sacrifice I am preparing for you, the great sacrifice on the mountains of Israel. There you will eat flesh and drink blood. <sup>18</sup> You will eat the flesh of mighty men and drink the blood of the princes of the earth as if they were rams and lambs, goats and bulls—all of them fattened animals from Bashan. 19 At the sacrifice I am preparing for you, you will eat fat till you are glutted and drink blood till you are drunk.

Matt. 24:28-Wherever there is a carcass, there the <u>vultures</u> will gather.

Rev. 18:2-And he cried out with a mighty voice, saying, "Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great! She has become a dwelling place of demons and a prison of every unclean spirit, and a prison of every unclean and hateful **bird**.

Rev. 19:17-18-<sup>17</sup> And I saw an angel standing in the sun, who cried in a loud voice to all the <u>birds</u> flying in midair, "Come, gather together for the great supper of God, <sup>18</sup> so

that you may eat the flesh of kings, generals, and the mighty, of horses and their riders, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, great and small."

## <u>19</u>

1 Sam. 31:9-9 They cut off his head and stripped off his weapons, and sent them throughout the land of the Philistines, to carry the good news to the house of their idols and to the people. <sup>10</sup> They put his weapons in the temple of Ashtaroth, and they **fastened his body to the wall of Beth-shan**.

Acts 14:19-But Jews came from Antioch and Iconium, and having won over the crowds, they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, **supposing him to be dead**.

Gal. 3:13-Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"—

Deut. 21:23-his corpse shall not hang all night on the <u>tree</u>, but you shall surely bury him on the same day (for he who is hanged is accursed of God), so that you do not defile your land which the Lord your God gives you as an inheritance.

## <u>22</u>

Rev. 22:6-And he said to me, "These words are faithful and true"; and the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent His angel to show to His bond-servants the things which must soon take place.

Gen. 41:1-Now it happened at the **end of two full years** that Pharaoh had a dream, and behold, he was standing by the Nile.

John 7:6-So Jesus said to them, "My time is not yet here, but your time is always opportune.

Isa. 49:16-"Behold, <u>I have inscribed you on the palms of My hands</u>; Your walls are continually before Me.

Matt. 28:20-teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, <u>I am with you always</u>, even to the end of the age.

Heb. 13:5-Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you,"
