1 Pet. 1:2-according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit, to obey Jesus Christ and be **<u>sprinkled</u>** with His blood: May grace and peace be yours in the fullest measure.

2 Tim. 4:6-For I am already being **<u>poured out</u>** as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come.

Matt. 3:16-After being baptized, <u>Jesus came up immediately</u> <u>from the water</u>; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove *and* lighting on Him

Mark 1:10-Immediately <u>coming up out of the water</u>, He saw the heavens opening, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon Him.

Rom. 6:3-5-³Or do you not know that all of us who have been <u>baptized into Christ Jesus have</u> been baptized into His <u>death</u>? ⁴Therefore we have been <u>buried</u> with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was <u>raised</u> from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. ⁵For if we have become united with *Him* in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be *in the likeness* of His <u>resurrection</u>.

Gen. 1:6-Then God said, "Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters, and let it <u>separate the waters from the waters</u>."

Gen. 1:9-Then God said, "Let the waters below the heavens be gathered into one place, and <u>let the dry land appear</u>"; and it was so.

2 Pet. 3:5-For when they maintain this, it escapes their notice that by the word of God *the* heavens existed long ago and *the* earth was formed out of water and by water.

2 Cor. 5:17-Therefore if anyone is in Christ, *he is* a <u>new</u> <u>creature</u>; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.

Acts 8:8-So there was much <u>rejoicing</u> in that city.

John 10:10-The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; <u>I</u> came that they may have life, and have *it* abundantly.

Deut. 10:13-*and* to keep the Lord's commandments and His statutes which I am commanding you today <u>for your good</u>?

1 John 5:3-For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and <u>His commandments are not burdensome</u>.

Matt. 11:28-29-²⁸ "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavyladen, and I will give you **rest**. ²⁹ Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find <u>rest</u> for your souls. ³⁰ For <u>My yoke is easy and My</u> <u>burden is light</u>."

Philip. 4:4-**<u>Rejoice</u>** in the Lord always; again I will say, <u>**rejoice**</u>!

Matt. 6:16-Whenever you fast, do not **put on a gloomy face** as the hypocrites *do*, for they neglect their appearance so that they will be noticed by men when they are fasting. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full. Acts 21:8-9-⁸On the next day we left and came to <u>Caesarea</u>, and entering the house of <u>Philip the evangelist</u>, who was one of the seven, we stayed with him.⁹Now this man had four virgin daughters who were prophetesses.
