Gen. 37:2- These are *the records of* the generations of Jacob. Joseph, when <u>seventeen years of age</u>, was pasturing the flock with his brothers while he was *still* a youth, along with the sons of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives. And Joseph brought back a bad report about them to their father.

Luke 3:23-When He began His ministry, Jesus Himself was about <u>thirty years of age</u>, being, as was supposed, the son of Joseph, the son of Eli.

Philip. 3:13-14-¹³ Brethren, <u>I do not regard myself as having</u> <u>laid hold of *it* yet</u>; but one thing *I do*: forgetting what *lies* behind and reaching forward to what *lies* ahead, ¹⁴ I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
