1 Thess. 1:10-and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus **who delivers us from the wrath to come**.

1 Thess. 5:9-For <u>God has not destined us for wrath</u>, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Mark 7:13-thus making void the word of God by your <u>tradition</u> that you have handed down. And many such things you do.

1 Thess. 2:13-And we also thank God constantly for this, that when you received the word of God, which you heard <u>from us</u>, <u>you</u> <u>accepted it not as the word of men but as what it really is, the</u> <u>word of God</u>, which is at work in you believers.

2 Pet. 3:2-that you should remember the words spoken beforehand by the holy **prophets** and the commandment of the Lord and Savior *spoken* by your **apostles**.

2 Pet. 3:15-16-¹⁵ and regard the patience of our Lord *as* salvation; just as also our beloved brother <u>Paul, according to the wisdom given</u> <u>him</u>, wrote to you, ¹⁶ as also in all *his* letters, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which the untaught and unstable distort, as *they do* also the rest of the Scriptures, to their own destruction.

1 Tim. 5:17-18-¹⁷ The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching.¹⁸ For the <u>Scripture</u> says, "<u>You shall not muzzle the ox</u> <u>while he is threshing</u>," and "<u>The laborer is worthy of his wages</u>."

1 Pet. 1:2-according to the foreknowledge of God the <u>Father</u>, by the sanctifying work of the <u>Spirit</u>, to obey <u>Jesus Christ</u> and be sprinkled with His blood: May grace and peace be yours in the fullest measure.

Rom. 5:8-But God <u>demonstrates</u> His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

John 3:16-For God so loved the world, that he **gave** his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

1 Cor. 13:4-7-⁴ Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant, ⁵ does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong suffered, ⁶ does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; ⁷ bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

2 Cor. 1:3-4-Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all <u>comfort</u>, who <u>comforts</u> us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to <u>comfort</u> those who are in any affliction, with the comfort with which we ourselves are <u>comforted</u> by God.

Eph. 2:8-9-For by **grace** you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

2 Cor. 1:3-4-Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all <u>comfort</u>, who <u>comforts</u> us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to <u>comfort</u> those who are in any affliction, with the comfort with which we ourselves are <u>comforted</u> by God.

Eph. 3:16-that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be **strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being.**

Eph. 2:10- For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good **works**, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

Eph. 4:29-Let no corrupting talk come out of your <u>mouths</u>, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.

1 Pet. 2:9-But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may **proclaim** the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

2 Thess. 1:4-5-therefore, we ourselves speak proudly of you among the churches of God for your perseverance and faith in the midst of all your **persecutions and afflictions** which you endure. This is a plain indication of God's righteous judgment so that you will be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which indeed you are **suffering**.
