Prov. 21:20-There is precious treasure and oil in the dwelling of the wise, but a foolish man swallows it up.

Eph. 4:28-He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have *something* to share with one who has need.

Prov. 27:12-A prudent man sees evil *and* hides himself, the naive proceed *and* pay the penalty.

Ps. 37:25-I have been young and now I am old, Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken or his descendants begging bread.

Gen. 41:14-Then Pharaoh sent and called for Joseph, and they hurriedly brought him out of the dungeon; and when he had shaved himself and **changed his clothes**, he came to Pharaoh.

Philip. 3:9-and may be found in Him, <u>not having a righteousness</u> <u>of my own</u> derived from *the* Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which *comes* from God on the basis of faith.

Gen. 3:7-Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they <u>sewed fig leaves</u> <u>together</u> and made themselves loin coverings.

Dan. 5:16-But I personally have heard about you, that you are able to give interpretations and solve difficult problems. Now if you are able to read the inscription and make its interpretation known to me, you will be **clothed** with purple and *wear* a **necklace** of gold around your neck, and you will have authority as the third *ruler* in the kingdom.

Dan. 5:29- Then Belshazzar gave orders, and they **clothed** Daniel with purple and *put* a **necklace** of gold around his neck and issued a proclamation concerning him that he *now* had authority as the third *ruler* in the kingdom.

Gen. 37:2- These are *the records of* the generations of Jacob. Joseph, when <u>seventeen years of age</u>, was pasturing the flock with his brothers while he was *still* a youth, along with the sons

of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives. And Joseph brought back a bad report about them to their father.

Luke 3:23-When He began His ministry, Jesus Himself was about **thirty years of age**, being, as was supposed, the son of Joseph, the son of Eli.
