

Gen. 41:14-Then Pharaoh sent and called for Joseph, and they hurriedly brought him out of the dungeon; and when he had shaved himself and **changed his clothes**, he came to Pharaoh.

Philip. 3:9-and may be found in Him, **not having a righteousness of my own** derived from *the* Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which *comes* from God on the basis of faith.

Gen. 3:7-Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they **sewed fig leaves together** and made themselves loin coverings.

Gen. 3:21-The Lord God made **garments of skin** for Adam and his wife and clothed them.

Isa. 64:6-For all of us have become like one who is unclean, and **all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment**; And all of us wither like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

John 21:7-Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord." So, when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he **put his outer garment on** (for he was stripped *for work*) and threw himself into the sea.

Dan. 5:7-The king called aloud to bring in the conjurers, the Chaldeans and the diviners. The king spoke and said to the wise men of Babylon, "Any man who can read this inscription and explain its interpretation to me shall be **clothed** with purple

and *have* a **necklace** of gold around his neck, and have authority as third *ruler* in the kingdom.”

Dan. 5:16-But I personally have heard about you, that you are able to give interpretations and solve difficult problems. Now if you are able to read the inscription and make its interpretation known to me, you will be **clothed** with purple and *wear* a **necklace** of gold around your neck, and you will have authority as the third *ruler* in the kingdom.

Dan. 5:29- Then Belshazzar gave orders, and they **clothed** Daniel with purple and *put* a **necklace** of gold around his neck and issued a proclamation concerning him that he *now* had authority as the third *ruler* in the kingdom.

### **43**

Philip. 2:10-11-<sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus **every knee will bow**, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

### **45**

Rev. 19:12-His eyes are a flame of fire, and on His head are many diadems; and He has a **name written on Him which no one knows except Himself**.

Gen. 46:20-Now to Joseph in the land of Egypt were born Manasseh and Ephraim, whom **Asenath, the daughter of Potiphera, priest of On**, bore to him.

2 Cor. 6:14-16-<sup>14</sup> **Do not be bound together with unbelievers;** for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? <sup>15</sup> Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? <sup>16</sup> Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM; AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE."

1 Cor. 7:2-5-<sup>2</sup> But because of immoralities, each man is to have his own wife, and each woman is to have her own husband.<sup>3</sup> The husband must fulfill his duty to his wife, and likewise also the wife to her husband. <sup>4</sup> The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband *does*; and likewise, also the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife *does*. <sup>5</sup> Stop depriving one another, except by agreement for a time, so that you may devote yourselves to prayer, and come together again so that Satan will not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

Eph. 5:22-24-<sup>22</sup> Wives, *be subject* to your own husbands, as to the Lord. <sup>23</sup> For the husband is the head of the wife, **as Christ also is the head of the church**, He Himself *being* the Savior of the body. <sup>24</sup> But as **the church is subject to Christ**, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything.

Rom. 12:14-21-<sup>14</sup> **Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.** <sup>15</sup> Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep. <sup>16</sup> Be of the same mind toward one another; do not be haughty in mind but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation. <sup>17</sup> **Never pay back evil for evil to**

**anyone.** Respect what is right in the sight of all men. <sup>18</sup>If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men. <sup>19</sup>**Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God, for it is written, “VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY,” says the Lord.** <sup>20</sup>**“BUT IF YOUR ENEMY IS HUNGRY, FEED HIM, AND IF HE IS THIRSTY, GIVE HIM A DRINK; FOR IN SO DOING YOU WILL HEAP BURNING COALS ON HIS HEAD.”** <sup>21</sup>**Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.**

Eph. 4:26-27-<sup>26</sup>BE ANGRY, AND *yet* DO NOT SIN; **do not let the sun go down on your anger,** <sup>27</sup> and do not give the devil an opportunity.

Eph. 4:32-Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, **forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.**

Luke 23:34-But Jesus was saying, **“Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.”** And they cast lots, dividing up His garments among themselves.

Acts 7:60-Then falling on his knees, he cried out with a loud voice, **“Lord, do not hold this sin against them!”** Having said this, he fell asleep.

## **46**

Gen. 37:2-These are *the records of* the generations of Jacob. Joseph, when **seventeen years of age,** was pasturing the flock with his brothers while he was *still* a youth, along with the sons

of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives. And Joseph brought back a bad report about them to their father.

Luke 3:23-When He began His ministry, Jesus Himself was about **thirty years of age**, being, as was supposed, the son of Joseph, the son of Eli.

Philip. 3:13-14- <sup>13</sup> Brethren, **I do not regard myself as having laid hold of it yet**; but one thing *I do*: forgetting what *lies* behind and reaching forward to what *lies* ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

## **51**

Rom. 8:18-For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us.

1 Pet. 5:10-After you have **suffered for a little while**, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen *and* establish you.

## **52**

Gen. 15:18-21-<sup>18</sup> On that day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying, "**To your descendants I have given this land, From the river of Egypt as far as the great river, the river Euphrates:** <sup>19</sup> the Kenite and the Kenizzite and the Kadmonite <sup>20</sup> and the Hittite and the Perizzite and the Rephaim <sup>21</sup> and the Amorite and the Canaanite and the Girgashite and the Jebusite."

John 15:5-I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears **much fruit**, for apart from Me you can do nothing.

John 15:8- My Father is glorified by this, that you bear **much fruit**, and so prove to be My disciples.

## **57**

Gen. 41:54-and the seven years of famine began to come, just as Joseph had said, then there was **famine in all the lands**, but in all the land of Egypt there was bread.

Gen. 41:56-When the **famine was spread over all the face of the earth**, then Joseph opened all the storehouses, and sold to the Egyptians; and the famine was severe in the land of Egypt.
