1 Cor. 10:13-No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and <u>God is faithful</u>, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

Heb. 2:17-Therefore, He had to be made like His brethren in all things, so that He might become a merciful and <u>faithful</u> high priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

Heb. 10:23-Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is <u>faithful</u>.

1 John 1:9-If we confess our sins, He is <u>faithful</u> and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matt. 6:13-And do not lead us into temptation but <u>deliver us</u> <u>from evil</u>. [For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.']

1 Pet. 5:8-Be of sober *spirit*, be on the alert. Your adversary, the **devil**, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

1 John 5:19-We know that we are of God, and that the **whole world** lies in *the power of* the evil one.

1 Thess. 2:18-For we wanted to come to you—I, Paul, more than once—and *yet* <u>Satan hindered us</u>.

Heb. 6:9-But, beloved, <u>we are convinced of better things</u> <u>concerning you</u>, and things that accompany salvation, though we are speaking in this way.

John 14:26-But <u>the Helper, the Holy Spirit</u>, whom the Father will send in My name, He will <u>teach</u> you all things, and bring to your <u>remembrance</u> all that I said to you.

John 16:12-13-¹² "<u>I have many more things to say to you, but you</u> <u>cannot bear them now</u>. ¹³ But when He, <u>the Spirit of truth, comes</u>, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you <u>what is to come</u>.

2 Thess. 2:15-So then, brethren, stand firm and hold to the traditions which you were taught, whether by word *of mouth* or by letter from <u>us</u>.

1 Thess. 2:13-For this reason we also constantly thank God that when you received the **word of God which you heard from us**, you accepted *it* not *as* the word of men, but *for* what it really is, the word of God, which also performs its work in you who believe.

1 Cor. 7:10-But to the married I give instructions, <u>not I, but the</u> <u>Lord</u>, that the wife should not leave her husband.

1 Cor. 7:12-But to the rest **I say, not the Lord**, that if any brother has a wife who is an unbeliever, and she consents to live with him, he must not divorce her.

<u>5</u>

Eph. 3:16-18-¹⁶ that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through

faith; *and* that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is <u>the breadth and length</u> <u>and height and depth.</u> ¹⁹ and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God.

Matt. 28:20-teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, <u>I am with you always, even to the end of the age</u>.

Heb. 13:5-6-⁵ *Make sure that* your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, "<u>I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you</u>," ⁶ so that we confidently say, "The Lord is my helper, I will not be afraid. What will man do to me?"

Heb. 13:8-Jesus Christ *is* the <u>same</u> yesterday and today and forever.

Gal. 5:22-23-²² But the fruit <u>of the Spirit</u> is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.
