Gen. 46:20-Now to Joseph in the land of Egypt were born Manasseh and Ephraim, whom Asenath, the daughter of Potiphera, priest of On, bore to him.

Rom. 8:18-For I consider that the <u>sufferings</u> of this present time are <u>not worthy to be compared</u> with the glory that is to be revealed to us.

1 Pet. 5:10-After you have <u>suffered for a little while</u>, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen *and* establish you.

- 1 John 2:15-17-¹⁵ Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. ¹⁶ For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world. ¹⁷ The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.
- 2 Tim. 4:10-<u>for Demas, because he loved this world, has</u> <u>deserted me</u> and has gone to Thessalonica. Crescens has gone to Galatia, and Titus to Dalmatia.
- Rom. 12:2-And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you

may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

John 15:8-My Father is glorified by this, that you bear **much fruit**, and *so* prove to be My disciples.

John 2:5-His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it."

<u>57</u>

Gen. 41:54-and the seven years of famine began to come, just as Joseph had said, then there was <u>famine in all the lands</u>, but in all the land of Egypt there was bread.

Gen. 41:56-When the <u>famine was spread</u> over all the face of the <u>earth</u>, then Joseph opened all the storehouses, and sold to the Egyptians; and the famine was severe in the land of Egypt.
