Gen. 35:18-It came about as her soul was departing (for she died), that she named him Ben-oni; but his father called him **Benjamin**.

Gen. 35:24- the sons of Rachel: Joseph and **Benjamin**.

Gen. 42:6-Now Joseph was the ruler over the land; he was the one who sold to all the people of the land. And Joseph's brothers came and **bowed** down to him with *their* faces to the ground.

Gen. 43:26-When Joseph came home, they brought into the house to him the present which was in their hand and **bowed** to the ground before him.

Gen. 43:28-They said, "Your servant our father is well; he is still alive." They **bowed down** in homage.

Gen. 44:14-When Judah and his brothers came to Joseph's house, he was still there, and they <u>fell to the ground before him</u>.

Gen. 37:2-These are *the records of* the generations of Jacob. Joseph, when <u>seventeen years of age</u>, was pasturing the flock with his brothers while he was *still* a youth, along with the sons of Bilhah and the sons of Zilpah, his father's wives. And Joseph brought back a bad report about them to their father.

Gen. 41:46-Now Joseph was <u>thirty years old</u> when he stood before Pharaoh, king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh and went through all the land of Egypt. 1 Tim. 3:6-*and* **not a new convert**, so that he will not become conceited and fall into the condemnation incurred by the devil.

Matt. 12:40-for just as Jonah was <u>three days and three nights</u> in the belly of the sea monster, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Prov. 1:7-The <u>fear of the Lord</u> is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Gen. 45:1-2-Then Joseph could not control himself before all those who stood by him, and he <u>cried</u>, "Have everyone go out from me." So there was no man with him when Joseph made himself known to his brothers.² He <u>wept</u> so loudly that the Egyptians heard *it*, and the household of Pharaoh heard *of it*.

Gen. 45:14-15-¹⁴ Then he fell on his brother Benjamin's neck and <u>wept</u>, and Benjamin wept on his neck.¹⁵ He kissed all his brothers and <u>wept</u> on them, and afterward his brothers talked with him.
