
Eric Metaxas

"[rescue Rapture Doctrine]...they think Jesus is going to rescue them. On the other hand there are a lot of people I've met that they're almost psyched to see the world go to hell. They're almost psyched to see everything get worse, like haha judgment is coming, instead of being moved by compassion to help those who might be helped. They're kind of glad to see it go downhill...and a lot of people who have this rescue Rapture rescue mentality...they're kind of like we we're happy to see America go down the tubes...and they're not even slightly patriotic thinking what can I do to help my nation stand for God's principles...I'm just about Jesus."



Benjamin Franklin

At the close of the Constitutional Convention of 1787, when queried as he left Independence Hall on the final day of deliberation (in the notes of Dr. James McHenry, one of Maryland's delegates to the Convention) a lady asked Dr. Benjamin Franklin, "Well Doctor what have we got a republic or a monarchy?" Franklin responded, "A republic replied the Doctor if you can keep it."
