Matt. 13:55-Is not this the <u>carpenter's son</u>? Is not His mother called Mary, and His brothers, James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?

1 Thess. 4:11-and to make it your ambition to lead a **quiet life** and attend to your own business and work with your hands, just as we commanded you.

Prov. 25:17-Let your foot <u>rarely</u> be in your <u>neighbor's house</u>, or he will become weary of you and hate you.

1 Tim. 5:8-But if anyone does not provide for his **own**, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

## <u>13</u>

Eccles. 11:4-He who watches the wind will **not sow** and he who looks at the clouds will **not reap**.

## <u>14</u>

2 Tim. 3:5-holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power; **Avoid such men as these**.

Matt. 18:15-17-<sup>15</sup> "If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother. <sup>16</sup> But if he does not listen *to you*, take one or two more with you, so that BY THE MOUTH OF TWO OR THREE WITNESSES EVERY FACT MAY BE CONFIRMED. <sup>17</sup> If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector.

- Philip. 3:18-For many walk, of whom I often told you, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are* **enemies** of the cross of Christ
- Matt. 13:25-But while his men were sleeping, his **enemy** came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went away
- Matt. 13:28-And he said to them, 'An <u>enemy</u> has done this!' The slaves said to him, 'Do you want us, then, to go and gather them up?'
- 1 Thess. 5:14-We urge you, <u>brethren</u>, admonish the unruly, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with everyone.
