1 Cor. 5:5-I have decided to deliver such a one to Satan for the **destruction of his flesh, so that his spirit may be saved** in the day of the Lord Jesus.

2 Cor. 2:6-8-⁶ Sufficient for such a one is this punishment which *was inflicted* by the majority, ⁷ so that on the contrary you should rather forgive and comfort *him*, otherwise such a one might be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow. ⁸ Wherefore I urge you to reaffirm *your* love for him.
