Gen. 42:15-16-¹⁵ by this you will be <u>tested</u>: by the life of Pharaoh, you shall not go from this place unless your youngest brother comes here! ¹⁶ Send one of you that he may get your brother, while you remain confined, that your words may be <u>tested</u>, whether there is truth in you. But if not, by the life of Pharaoh, surely you are spies.

<u>22</u>

Gen. 42:25-Then Joseph gave orders to fill their bags with grain and to restore every man's **money** in his sack, and to give them provisions for the journey. And thus, it was done for them.

<u>23</u>

Philip. 4:6-7-⁶Be <u>anxious</u> for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.⁷ And the <u>peace</u> of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

2 Tim. 1:7-For God has not given us a spirit of <u>timidity</u>, but of power, love, and discipline.

1 Pet. 5:7-casting <u>all</u> your <u>anxiety</u> on Him, because He cares for you.

Gen. 42:24-He turned away from them and wept. But when he returned to them and spoke to them, he took Simeon from them and bound him before their eyes.

Gen. 45:1-2-Then Joseph could not control himself before all those who stood by him, and he <u>cried</u>, "Have everyone go out from me." So, there was no man with him when Joseph made himself known to his brothers.² He <u>wept</u> so loudly that the Egyptians heard *it*, and the household of Pharaoh heard *of it*.

Gen. 45:14-15-¹⁴ Then he fell on his brother Benjamin's neck and <u>wept</u>, and Benjamin wept on his neck.¹⁵ He kissed all his brothers and <u>wept</u> on them, and afterward his brothers talked with him.

John 11:35-Jesus wept.

Gen. 46:34-you shall say, 'Your servants have been keepers of livestock from our youth even until now, both we and our fathers,' that you may live in the land of Goshen; <u>for every shepherd</u> <u>is loathsome to the Egyptians</u>."

1 Pet. 2:2-like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may **grow** in respect to salvation.
